**Chairman Crane (13)** called the meeting to order at 9:00 AM.

**MOTION:** **Rep. Coberly** made a motion to approve the minutes of January 15th, 2024 and January 16th, 2024. **Motion carried by voice vote.**

**H 390:** **Chairman Crane (13)** explained he was told by the bill sponsor he was unavailable today. They will hear the bill at a later date. **Rep. Palmer** made a motion to **HOLD H 390** subject of the call of the chair. **Motion carried by voice vote.**

**H 394:  
RS 30978:** **Rep. Raybould** presented **H 394**, the request to hold this bill in committee and instead introduce the revised **RS 30978** is due to a technical correction within the legislation, the intent of the proposed legislation remains the same. There was a section of code that was not included in the bill that is included in the new RS. This legislation repeals 67-5709a, which outlines a modified process for the sale of surplus state administrative facilities. Under existing state law, sale of surplus property goes through The Land Board, however under 67-5709a it is handled by the Department of Administration. This legislation ensures all sales go back to regular established order from state code by striking the abbreviated process. In response to committee questions Rep. Raybould explained the legislative history that was generated for this topic, did not reveal additional historical context for why the abbreviated process was created. She also highlighted section 58-335 of Idaho Code which lists lands exempt from the act, which includes lands owned by the State Board of Education.

**MOTION:** **Rep. Young** made a motion to **HOLD H 394** in committee and introduce **RS 30978** and recommend it be sent directly to the second reading calendar. **Motion carried by voice vote.** **Rep. Raybould** will sponsor the bill on the floor.

**ADJOURN:** There being no further business to come before the Committee, the meeting adjourned at 9:15 AM.
