Chair Horman called the meeting to order at 9:16 a.m.

Rep. Raybould could not attend the Appropriations Committee meeting; she was presenting bills in another committee.

S 1312: **Sen. Abby Lee** presented **S 1312** for **Rep. Raybould**. She explained this legislation creates parity in budget deadlines. Under current law, only the Executive Branch is required to meet a September budget deadline; this bill requires the same deadline for the Legislative and Judicial Branches of government.

MOTION: **Rep. Furniss** made a motion, seconded by **Rep. Miller**, to send **S 1312** to the floor with a **DO PASS** recommendation.

In response to a committee question, **Ms. Misty Lawrence**, Budget Bureau Chief, Division of Financial Management (DFM), stated DFM reviews the legislative and judicial budgets from a technical perspective. Those budgets are submitted to both DFM and the Legislative Services Office (LSO) at the same time. If these budgets are submitted by September 1st, DFM will be able to perform a more thorough technical review. The budgets will be posted on the DFM website at the same time all other budgets are posted.

VOTE ON MOTION: **Motion carried by a voice vote. Rep. Raybould** will sponsor the bill on the floor.

ADJOURN: There being no further business to come before the committee, the meeting adjourned at 9:23 a.m.

Chair Miller called the meeting to order at 9:36 a.m.

H 730: **Rep. Horman** presented **H 730**. This legislation updates Title 67 Chapter 19 & 35 in Idaho Code relating to annual budget reporting by state agencies. This directs state agencies receiving federal funds, anticipating receipts of federal funds or administering programs supported by federal funds to add, or adjust reporting requirements. It requires reporting if federal funds are capped, or are open-ended, or if the state is required to match federal dollars. It also requires agencies to develop a plan to reduce or eliminate services if notified of a reduction in federal funding within a specific federal grant of 10% or more. This also adds language which requires reporting to the Legislative Services Office.

MOTION: **Rep. Tanner** made a motion to send **H 730** to the floor with a **DO PASS** recommendation. **Motion carried by voice vote.** **Rep. Horman** will sponsor the bill on the floor.

ADJOURN: There being no further business to come before the committee, the meeting adjourned at 9:39 a.m.
