ELECTION OF SPEAKER

The Honorable Secretary of State announced that the next business in order is the election of a Speaker of the House of Representatives, of the Forty-fifth Legislature, and announced that nominations for Speaker are now in order.

Honorable Harry N. Graves of Williamson County nominated Honorable Robert W. Calvert of Hill County.

Honorable W. B. Carssow of Bexar County seconded the nomination of Honorable Robert W. Calvert.

Honorable John J. Bell of De Witt County seconded the nomination of Hon. Robert W. Calvert.

Honorable Fred E. Knetsch of Guadalupe County seconded the nomination of Honorable Robert W. Calvert and moved that nominations for Speaker of the House be now closed and that the Chief Clerk be instructed to cast the entire vote of the House for Honorable Robert W. Calvert for Speaker.

The motion prevailed unanimously. In accordance with the above action, the Chief Clerk then cast the entire vote of the House for Honorable Robert W. Calvert for Speaker.

The Honorable Secretary of State declared Honorable Robert W. Calvert to be the duly elected Speaker of the House of Representatives of the Forty-fifth Legislature.
