Preschool-12th Grade Education Assistance Scholarship

The purpose of the Preschool – 12th Grade Education Assistance Scholarship program is to assist with the cost of the educational needs for all LTBB students in Preschool through 12th grade.

Program Criteria:

- A scholarship is available to all Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians Tribal citizens who
 provide proof of enrollment in a preschool program (qualifying preschool programs such as Head
- Start, Great Start School Readiness Program, or Public-School affiliated programs must be accredited by a State Dept. of Education and follow National program standards and outcomes), grades K-12, or a home school program.
- A completed application must be submitted for **each** student and signed by the legal parent or
- guardian, unless the student is 18, in which the student may sign his/her own application.
- An application for a child who is in foster care or is a ward of the Court must be completed by the appropriate Department and signed by the Director of Tribal Court and/or Human Services as deemed necessary.
- Each student will receive a scholarship award of \$100.00 for educational and/or extracurricular expenses.
- A scholarship is available only once per academic year per student; the academic year is defined
- as August 1 July 31.
- 6. Additional documentation may be required to process the scholarship application.
