Former Victories Site Task Force

In the Waganakising Odawak Constitution, Article VIII, Section C, Paragraph 4, the Powers and Duties of the Tribal Chairperson include the following: "To make recommendations to the Tribal Council on matters of interest of benefit to the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians".

The Tribally owned properties including 1967 US 131 S in Petoskey, Michigan on which Victories Casino operated and developable area on Tribally owned adjacent parcels is now available for new use and potential development. Research is needed to analyze the property's economic development options. A taskforce is herby created to perform research and analysis on the future use of the property. The task force is charged with preparing a report with supporting recommendations for use of the property to the Tribal Chairman.

The members of the task force will be 1) the Director of the Planning Department who shall chair the task force, 2) the Geographic Information Systems Director, 3) the Office of Enterprise Management Director, 4) a representative from the Executive Office, and 5) a representative from the Economic Development Commission. The task force will coordinate with a committee yet to be appointed by the Tribal Council that will be designated to work on this same issue.

This Executive Directive becomes effective February 20, 2009, and will remain in effect until the task force issues its final report or until rescinded by a subsequent Executive action.
