Hazard Pay for Personal Protection Equipment Distribution Events

The Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians Tribal Constitution adopted February 1, 2005 creates the Executive Branch of the Tribal Government and the Tribal Chairperson is the elected official who exercises Executive Authority under the Constitution.

Article VII, Section C, Paragraph 5 places the following responsibility on the Tribal Chairperson: "To oversee all Tribal Executive departments, boards, commissions and committees created by Tribal Council."

On March 17, 2020 the Tribal Chairperson issued Executive Emergency Order declaring a State of Emergency due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

From October 17, 2020 thru the end of LTBB Phase II of the COVID-19 reopening, employees who work an approved LTBB sponsored Personal Protective Distribution event shall receive Hazard Pay in the amount of \$10.00 per hour. This does not include travel time, hours utilized for PTO or any leave provided by LTBB.

This timeframe may be extended by a subsequent Executive Directive.

This Executive Directive becomes effective October 17, 2020 and remains if effective until the end of Phase II Reopening.
