SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Education

21-301.

- (a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.
- (b) "Disability" means any [defect or infirmity that may incapacitate an individual totally or partially for gainful] PHYSICAL OR MENTAL IMPAIRMENT THAT CONSTITUTES OR RESULTS IN A SUBSTANTIAL IMPEDIMENT TO employment or independent living.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2024.
