To provide for diverse recreational opportunities and amenities that enhance the quality of life for our residents and visitors to the City of Frederick through the creation, operation, and maintenance of a comprehensive parks and recreation department.

We seek a \$500,000 State grant to advance further repairs and enhancements to park amenities for low to moderate-income neighborhoods. The necessity for such support is underscored by the extensive park network within the City, which has grown to 75 parks. Upgrades to these green spaces are essential to accommodate our burgeoning population growth, particularly in areas designated as Equity Emphasis Areas by the MWCOG. The requested funds, allocated specifically for design and construction, will play a pivotal role in ensuring that our parks meet the evolving needs of the community, enhancing accessibility, and providing quality recreational resources for residents in these designated areas.
