<b>10. Description and Purpose of Organization</b> (Limit length to visible area)		
<p>The Town of Glen Echo is a small town with a large stormwater management problem. With a population of 255 residents in 97 houses, Glen Echo is bordered by MacArthur Blvd, Clara Barton Parkway, and National Park Service land and lies downhill from the Bannockburn neighborhood in Bethesda. We have been incorporated since 1904.</p>		

**11. Description and Purpose of Project** (Limit length to visible area)

Water routinely floods the first floor of the town hall and surges downhill into residents homes. Runoff polluted by asphalt, pesticides, and fertilizers rushes over our yards and streets, towards the Potomac River via the lower Mainstem of the Cabin John Creek watershed and the Minnehaha Branch of the Little Falls watershed. Our goal is to keep this polluted runoff from reaching the Potomac River, prevent erosion of the surrounding forested areas, and decrease town and residential property damage. We won two grants from The Chesapeake Bay Trust (CBT) and they provided funding for an initial site assessment, drainage study, and designs for two high-priority bioretention facilities and rain gardens. We now need funding to allow us to hire contractors to install these stormwater management designs, preventing further damage to municipal and private properties and stemming the flow of pollutants into the Potomac River.
