<p>To make strategic updates, modernizations, and enhance accessibility to the Knights of Columbus Patapsco Council #1960s Building in order to continue to serve as a community hub and activity space. The building was built in the 1800s and has served as the KofC Council Home since 1921. While we are a fraternal organization that runs and manages the building, we have never shied away from hosting community forums, the local chamber of commerce, and the Catonsville 4th of July Celebrations Committee. We have begun our first ever Capital Campaign and would benefit from state support to ensure an accessible and welcoming space during our next 100 years.</p>

Globally and historically, The Knights of Columbus (KofC) is a Catholic fraternal service order founded in 1882. Locally we are an organization of community members, residents, and volunteers that value our community and the historic impact the Patapsco Council has made over our 100+ years of service. As a religious fraternal organization our membership is limited to the criteria set by the National Council, but our presence and service in the community has never been restricted by religion, gender, class, or creed. Our council building has allowed us the opportunity to offer meeting space, community forums, and facilitate community engagement with numerous nonprofits that reside in the Baltimore region. As a local council we are committed to fostering community engagement and mutual support while also maintaining our organizational commitment to our Catholic membership.
