10. Description and Purpose of Organization (Limit length to visible area)		
Howard County Government via the Howard County Department of Recreation and Parks. The Howard County Department of Recreation and Parks is responsible for the stewardship of over 9,600 acres of public lands; the maintenance and operation of more than 30 parks, 4 natural resource areas, 26 historic sites, 3 community centers, a nature center, an athletic center, and various other facilities; and offering over 7,000 recreational programs. The mission of the Department is to responsibly manage natural resources; provide excellent parks, facilities, and recreation opportunities for the community; and ensure the highest quality of life for current and future generations.

The Howard County Department of Recreation and Parks is requesting a \$250,000 State Bond Bill to renovate the existing restroom facility at Rockburn Branch Park that is over 35 years old. The renovation will include a family restroom with adult changing table and renovations to the existing restrooms.
