<p>The Harford County Department of Parks and Recreation provides many quality of life enhancements to the Countys residents. The Department develops, operates, and maintains both active and passive recreation facilities, and it works closely with some 20 Recreation Councils throughout the County to identify ever increasing leisure needs of the many communities it serves. The Departments principal efforts include providing diverse forms of leisure, preserving open land space, and promoting environmental conservation. Currently, the Department maintains and utilizes over 4,891 acres of parkland which hosts some 96 county parks and playgrounds, 10 Activity Centers, and two Nature Centers.</p>
