Admin Building Severe Weather Drill

The severe weather shelter in place drill for the Admin Building is scheduled for **Thursday April 20 at 11:00 AM.**

If you are working remotely

- Please take this opportunity to identify shelter areas at your location and practice sheltering in place.
- For those of you reporting to your usual workplace or working in a new area or building, please locate to your identified workplace shelter areas.



Procedure for the drill

- Review and update your contact information in Self-Service
- An announcement will be made via PA system at the start of the drill.
- An all clear will be announced via PA system at the end of the drill.



What to do during a real severe weather event

- Go directly to an enclosed, windowless area in the center of the building, the lowest floor possible
- Stay away from glass and windows
- Interior stairwells are also good places to shelter.
- Crouch down and cover your head.
- Do not use elevators; you could be trapped if the power is lost.
