The 20-day review period for the October 1, 2016 federal funds submission to the Legislative Advisory Commission (LAC), under the provision in Minnesota Statute 3.3005, subdivision 6, has ended. The attached requests received no recommendation by members of the LAC. They are hereby approved and available to the agencies for allotment.

The \$105 million *Fixing America's Surface Transportation Act* funding, awarded to the Department of Transportation, received a negative recommendation and will not be approved for allotment.
