Dear Senators and Representatives:

This communication is to inform you that our full *November 2020 Budget and Economic Forecast* document and information have been posted on the Minnesota Management and Budget website, <u>https://mn.gov/mmb/</u>.

Additionally, this communication is also a notification that the positive budgetary balance projected in the current biennium triggered a provision in M.S. 16A.152 that requires a transfer from the general fund to the 21st Century Minerals fund when a surplus is projected. That transfer of \$5 million has been included in spending estimates for the current biennium in the documents posted today. Inclusion of this transfer reduces the available balance in the current biennium to \$636 million.

MMB staff are prepared to answer any questions you may have on the *November 2020 Budget and Economic Forecast*.
