OTHER REGULATIONS

- No fireworks may be possessed or discharged in any public park, which is a civil infraction.
- By state law, fireworks sales are limited to people age 16 and older.
- Hours Allowed for Discharge of Legal Fireworks in Snoqualmie:
July 4, 2016 from 9 a.m. to midnight
December 31, 10 p.m. to 12:30 p.m.
