	WHEREAS, the emergency radio system used by 19 local law
18	enforcement and 22 fire protection agencies throughout Snohomish County to
19	communicate with each other and with countywide 911 emergency dispatch has
20	reached the end of its useful life; and

22	WHEREAS, uninterrupted critical communications capability and
23	infrastructure are necessary to conduct effective emergency public safety
24	operations involving first responders; and

26	WHEREAS, the health, welfare and safety of the residents, visitors and
27	businesses in Snohomish County require that the county, fire districts, cities, and
28	towns have emergency communications capability in order to provide life-saving,
29	vital police and fire services to the public in a timely, reliable, and effective

32	WHEREAS, the Snohomish County Emergency Radio System (SERS)
33	Board has requested that Snohomish County authorize funding to provide for the
34	purchase, design, installation and operation of a new emergency radio system to

38	WHEREAS, RCW 82.14.420 authorizes the county to submit an
