Following the award meeting, recommendations will be submitted to the Board of Pacific County Commissioners for their consideration.

If approved by the Commissioners, applicants will enter into a Contract for Services and must:

- 1. Fulfill the terms of the contract.
- 2. Abide by all Washington State requirements.
- 3. Promote/acknowledge the Pacific County Lodging Tax Grant during the event/activity.



Pacific County Lodging Tax Grant Application

The grant application is required to meet the following criteria as established by State law (RCW 67.28.1815) and County policy:

 Used solely for the purpose of paying all or any part of the cost of tourism promotion, acquisition of tourism-related facilities, or operation of tourism-related facilities. Municipalities may, under chapter 39.34 RCW, agree to the utilization of revenue from taxes imposed under this chapter for the purposes of funding a multijurisdictional tourism-related facility.

The definitions within Chapter 67.28.080 RCW and County policy apply to the use and administration of these funds.

Acquisition* includes, but is not limited to, siting, acquisition, design, construction, refurbishing, expansion, repair, and improvement, including paying or securing the payment of all or any portion of general obligation bonds, leases, revenue bonds, or other obligations issued or incurred for such purpose or purposes under this chapter.

*Acquisitions for capital expenditures are typically not funded through the grant application process

Municipality means any county, city or town of the state of Washington.

Operation includes, but is not limited to, operation, management, and marketing.

Person means the federal government or any agency thereof, the state or any agency, subdivision, taxing district or Municipal Corporation thereof other than county, city or town, any private corporation, partnership, association, or individual.

Tourism means economic activity resulting from tourists, which may include sales of overnight lodging, meals, tours, gifts, or souvenirs.

Tourism promotion (RCW 67.28.1816) means activities, operations, and expenditures designed to increase tourism, including but not limited to advertising, publicizing, or otherwise distributing information for the purpose of attracting and welcoming tourists; developing strategies to expand tourism; operating tourism promotion agencies; and funding the marketing of or the operation of special events and festivals designed to attract tourists.

Tourism-related facility means real or tangible personal property with a usable life of three or more years, or constructed with volunteer labor that is: (a)(i) Owned by a public entity; (ii) owned by a nonprofit organization described under section 501(c)(3) of the federal internal revenue code of 1986, as amended; or (iii) owned by a nonprofit organization described under section 501(c)(6) of the federal internal revenue code of 1986, as amended, a business organization, destination marketing organization, main street organization, lodging association, or chamber of commerce and (b) used to support tourism, performing arts, or to accommodate tourist activities.

Standard Funding means the organization had received three consecutive years of grant funding and a letter of interest is sent into the Lodging Tax Advisory Clerk for Committee review. If the amounts awarded are different, an average will be awarded. Each year the organization will receive a standard level of funding, depending on the fiscal year budget, and as long as the application scope of work provided demonstrates constant service of work.
