United States Postal Service Post OfficeTM and Collection Box Products Data License Agreement

This License Agreement ("**Agreement**") is between YOU, the LICENSEE as designated on the signature page of this agreement and on your Post OfficeTM and Collection Box Products Order Form submission ("**LICENSEE**" or "**YOU**") and the United States Postal Service, an independent establishment of the executive branch of the Government of the United States, with its headquarters located at 475 L'Enfant Plaza, SW, Washington, DC 20260 ("**LICENSOR**" or "**USPS**"). LICENSOR and LICENSEE may be referred to herein collectively as the "**Parties**" or individually as a "**Party**."

THIS AGREEMENT CONSTITUTES THE COMPLETE AGREEMENT BETWEEN YOU AND USPS. BY SIGNING AND RETURNING THIS DATA LICENSE AGREEMENT AND THE POST OFFICE AND COLLECTION BOX PRODUCTS ORDER FORM, YOU INDICATE YOUR AGREEMENT TO THE TERMS OF THIS AGREEMENT. IF YOU DO NOT AGREE TO THE TERMS OF THIS AGREEMENT, DO NOT SIGN AND RETURN THIS AGREEMENT OR THE POST OFFICE AND COLLECTION BOX PRODUCTS ORDER FORM.

- 1. Grant of License. Subject to and conditioned on LICENSEE's payment of the Fee and compliance with all terms and conditions of this Agreement, LICENSOR hereby grants LICENSEE a non-exclusive, non-sublicensable, and non-transferable license during the Term to Use the data relating to the geographical locations of Post Office facilities and/or Collection Boxes, as identified in the Post OfficeTM and Collection Box Products Order Form ("Order Form") and defined in the Appendix ("USPS Post Office Location Dataset," "USPS Collection Box Location Dataset," or both datasets, generically and collectively "Data" for purposes of this agreement) for incorporation into Licensee's technology, software, service, platform and/or product listed by YOU in Exhibit A (the "Permitted Use"). "Use" means that the Licensee may copy, modify, distribute and display the Data in connection with the Permitted Use.
- 2. <u>Data Use Restrictions</u>. LICENSEE shall use the Data for the Permitted Use only and shall not disclose, release, distribute, or deliver the Data, any portion of the Data, or any other information derived from the Data to any third party without LICENSOR's prior written consent. For the avoidance of doubt, LICENSEE may incorporate the Data into the products or services listed in Exhibit A, but no Data either in whole or in part may be transferred or sold by LICENSEE. Any purpose or use not specifically authorized herein is prohibited, unless otherwise agreed to in writing by LICENSOR. Without limiting the foregoing and except as otherwise expressly set forth in 1(a), LICENSEE shall not at any time, directly or indirectly: (i) permit non-parties to this Agreement to copy, modify, distribute, or display the Data, any portion of the Data, or any other information derived from the Data; (ii) rent, lease, lend, sell, sublicense,

assign, distribute, publish, transfer, or otherwise make available the Data; (iii) reverse engineer, disassemble, decompile, decode, adapt, or otherwise attempt to derive or gain access to the source of the Data or methods used to compile the Data, in whole or in part; (iv) remove any proprietary notices included within the Data; (v) publish, distribute, or display any compilation or directory of the Data or based upon information derived from the Data; (vi) use LICENSOR's trademarks, trade names, service marks, logos, or other distinctive brand features; (vii) use the Data in a manner that disparages or negatively effects the USPS; or (viii) use the Data in any manner or for any purpose that infringes, misappropriates, or otherwise violates any intellectual property right or other right of any person, or that violates any applicable law.

- 3. Reservation of Rights in Data. LICENSOR reserves all rights not expressly granted to LICENSEE in this Agreement. Except for the limited rights and licenses expressly granted under this Agreement, nothing in this Agreement grants, by implication, waiver, estoppel, or otherwise, to LICENSEE or any third party any intellectual property rights or other right, title, or interest in or to the Data.
- 4. <u>Intellectual Property Ownership</u>. LICENSEE acknowledges that, as between LICENSEE and LICENSOR, LICENSOR owns all right, title, and interest, including all intellectual property rights, in and to the Data.
- 5. <u>Delivery</u>. LICENSOR shall make available to the LICENSEE the Data electronically in either comma-delimited or GeoJSON format as indicated on the Order Form via LICENSOR's Electronic Product Fulfillment portal. LICENSOR shall deliver the first Data within twenty (20) business days of receipt of payment by LICENSOR of the Fee. LICENSOR shall deliver updated Data via its Electronic Product Fulfillment portal on a monthly basis, on the first working day of the month, during the Term.
- 6. <u>Fee and Payment</u>. LICENSEE shall pay LICENSOR the annual fee for each Term ("**Fee**") set forth in the Order Form at the time the Order Form is returned to USPS.
- 7. <u>Data Security</u>. LICENSEE shall use all reasonable legal, organizational, physical, administrative, and technical measures, and security procedures to safeguard and ensure the security of the Data and to protect the Data from unauthorized access, disclosure, duplication, use, modification, or loss. LICENSEE will notify LICENSOR within twenty-four (24) hours of any incident involving unauthorized access, disclosure, duplication, use, modification, or loss of the Data to the following email address: CyberSafe@usps.gov.
- 8. <u>DISCLAIMER OF WARRANTIES</u>. THE DATA IS PROVIDED "AS IS" AND LICENSOR HEREBY DISCLAIMS ALL WARRANTIES, WHETHER EXPRESS, IMPLIED, STATUTORY, OR OTHERWISE. LICENSOR SPECIFICALLY DISCLAIMS ALL IMPLIED WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY, FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE, TITLE, AND NON-INFRINGEMENT, AND

- ALL WARRANTIES ARISING FROM COURSE OF DEALING, USAGE, OR TRADE PRACTICE. LICENSOR MAKES NO WARRANTY OF ANY KIND THAT THE DATA OR ANY PRODUCTS OR RESULTS OF ITS USE WILL MEET LICENSEE'S REQUIREMENTS, OPERATE WITHOUT INTERRUPTION, ACHIEVE ANY INTENDED RESULT, BE COMPATIBLE OR WORK WITH ANY SOFTWARE, SYSTEM, OR OTHER SERVICES, OR BE SECURE, ACCURATE, COMPLETE, FREE OF HARMFUL CODE, OR ERROR FREE.
- 9. <u>Indemnification</u>. LICENSEE shall indemnify, hold harmless, and, at LICENSOR's option, defend LICENSOR from and against any Losses resulting from any Third-Party Claim based on LICENSEE's: (i) negligence or willful misconduct in using the Data for the Permitted Use; and (ii) use of the Data in a manner not authorized by this Agreement, provided that LICENSEE may not settle any Third-Party Claim against LICENSOR unless such settlement completely and forever releases LICENSOR from all liability with respect to such Third-Party Claim or unless LICENSOR consents to such settlement, and further provided that LICENSOR shall have the right, at its option, to defend itself against any such Third-Party Claim or to participate in the defense thereof by counsel of its own choice. Nothing in this paragraph shall impact the discretion of the United States Department of Justice to take any appropriate action concerning this Agreement.
- 10. LIMITATIONS OF LIABILITY. IN NO EVENT WILL LICENSOR BE LIABLE UNDER OR IN CONNECTION WITH THIS AGREEMENT UNDER ANY LEGAL OR EQUITABLE THEORY, INCLUDING BREACH OF CONTRACT, TORT (INCLUDING NEGLIGENCE), STRICT LIABILITY, AND OTHERWISE, FOR ANY (A) CONSEQUENTIAL, INCIDENTAL, INDIRECT, EXEMPLARY, SPECIAL, ENHANCED, OR PUNITIVE DAMAGES, (B) INCREASED COSTS, DIMINUTION IN VALUE, OR LOST BUSINESS, PRODUCTION, REVENUES, OR PROFITS, (C) LOSS OF GOODWILL OR REPUTATION, (D) USE, INABILITY TO USE, LOSS, INTERRUPTION, DELAY, OR RECOVERY OF ANY DATA OR BREACH OF DATA OR SYSTEM SECURITY, OR (E) COST OF REPLACEMENT GOODS OR SERVICES, IN EACH CASE REGARDLESS OF WHETHER LICENSOR WAS ADVISED OF THE POSSIBILITY OF SUCH LOSSES OR DAMAGES OR SUCH LOSSES OR DAMAGES WERE OTHERWISE FORESEEABLE. IN NO EVENT WILL LICENSOR'S AGGREGATE LIABILITY ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THIS AGREEMENT, UNDER ANY LEGAL OR EQUITABLE THEORY, INCLUDING BREACH OF CONTRACT, TORT (INCLUDING NEGLIGENCE), STRICT LIABILITY, AND OTHERWISE, EXCEED THE FEE PAID TO LICENSOR UNDER THIS AGREEMENT.

11. Term and Termination.

(a) <u>Term</u>. This Agreement is granted for a term of one year from October 1 through the following September 30. If this Agreement is entered into other than on October

1 in any year, the term will be less than one year and begin on the date of USPS' receipt of payment by LICENSEE of the pro-rated Fee to the following September 30. Approximately sixty days before the end of any term, LICENSOR may, in its sole discretion, offer to renew the Agreement for a one year term. This will be way of a renewal notice from the Electronic Product Fulfillment Portal to LICENSEE. If LICENSEE pays the new Fee, this Agreement will be renewed for an additional one year term. Without such offer to renew and full payment, no new term will be granted. Each term is also subject to termination and discontinuance as provided in this Agreement.

(b) Termination.

- (i) LICENSOR may terminate this Agreement, effective on written notice to LICENSEE, if LICENSEE fails to pay any amount when due hereunder or breaches any of its obligations under this Agreement.
- (ii) Either Party may terminate this Agreement, effective on written notice to the other Party, if the other Party materially breaches this Agreement, and such breach: (A) is incapable of cure; or (B) being capable of cure, remains uncured ten days after the non-breaching Party provides the breaching Party with written notice of such breach.
- (c) <u>Discontinuance of Licensing</u>. In the event LICENSOR elects to discontinue licensing the Data, USPS shall provide written notice to LICENSEE at least 90 days before the discontinuation date ("**Discontinuation Date**"). In the event the Discontinuation Date occurs after the end of the current Term, LICENSEE may, at LICENSOR's discretion, renew the license for a partial renewal term that ends on the Discontinuation Date ("**Partial Renewal Term**"), provided that LICENSEE pays LICENSOR the pro-rated Fees for the Partial Renewal Term in accordance with this Agreement. In the event of termination by LICENSOR, LICENSEE may be refunded its Fee on a pro-rata basis unless termination is due to a breach of this Agreement.
- (d) Effect of Expiration or Termination. Upon expiration or earlier termination of this Agreement, the license granted hereunder will also terminate. Upon termination, LICENSEE's obligations under Section 7 will continue. LICENSEE may continue using Data in its possession for the Permitted Use only, but LICENSOR will not deliver monthly updates as specified in Section 5. No expiration or termination will affect LICENSEE's obligation to pay all Fees that may have become due before such expiration or termination.

12. Miscellaneous.

- (a) <u>Force Majeure</u>. In no event shall LICENSOR be liable to LICENSEE or be deemed to have breached this Agreement, for any failure or delay in performing its obligations under this Agreement, if and to the extent such failure or delay is caused by any circumstances beyond LICENSOR's reasonable control, including but not limited to acts of God, flood, fire, earthquake, explosion, epidemics, pandemics, war, terrorism, invasion, riot or other civil unrest, strikes, labor stoppages or slowdowns or other industrial disturbances, or passage of law or any action taken by a governmental or public authority, including imposing an embargo.
- (b) Amendment and Modification; Waiver. No amendment to or modification of this Agreement is effective unless it is in writing and signed by an authorized representative of each Party. No waiver by any Party of any of the provisions hereof will be effective unless explicitly set forth in writing and signed by the Party so waiving. Except as otherwise set forth in this Agreement, (i) no failure to exercise, or delay in exercising, any rights, remedy, power, or privilege arising from this Agreement will operate or be construed as a waiver thereof and (ii) no single or partial exercise of any right, remedy, power, or privilege hereunder will preclude any other or further exercise thereof or the exercise of any other right, remedy, power, or privilege.
- (c) <u>Severability</u>. If any provision of this Agreement is invalid, illegal, or unenforceable in any jurisdiction, such invalidity, illegality, or unenforceability will not affect any other term or provision of this Agreement or invalidate or render unenforceable such term or provision in any other jurisdiction. Upon such determination that any term or other provision is invalid, illegal, or unenforceable, the Parties hereto shall negotiate in good faith to modify this Agreement so as to effect the original intent of the Parties as closely as possible in a mutually acceptable manner in order that the transactions contemplated hereby be consummated as originally contemplated to the greatest extent possible.
- (d) <u>Survival</u>. Any rights, obligations, or required performance of the parties in this Agreement which, by their express terms or nature and context are intended to survive termination or expiration of this Agreement, will survive any such termination or expiration, including the rights and obligations set forth in Section 2, Section 4, and Section 7.
- (e) Governing Law; Venue; Submission to Jurisdiction. This Agreement is governed by and construed in accordance with the federal laws of the United States. Venue for any dispute under this Agreement lays in the federal courts for the District of Columbia. Both parties consent and submit to the jurisdiction of the United States District Court for the District of Columbia.

- (f) <u>Assignment</u>. LICENSEE may not assign or transfer any of its rights or delegate any of its obligations hereunder, in each case whether voluntarily, involuntarily, by operation of law, or otherwise, without the prior written consent of LICENSOR. Any purported assignment, transfer, or delegation in violation of this Section is null and void. No assignment, transfer, or delegation will relieve the assigning or delegating Party of any of its obligations hereunder. This Agreement is binding upon and inures to the benefit of the Parties hereto and their respective permitted successors and assigns.
- (g) Equitable Relief. Each Party acknowledges and agrees that a breach or threatened breach by LICENSEE of any of its obligations under this Agreement would cause the LICENSOR irreparable harm for which monetary damages would not be an adequate remedy and agrees that, in the event of such breach or threatened breach, the LICENSOR will be entitled to equitable relief, including a restraining order, an injunction, specific performance, and any other relief that may be available from any court, without any requirement to post a bond or other security, or to prove actual damages or that monetary damages are not an adequate remedy. Such remedies are not exclusive and are in addition to all other remedies that may be available at law, in equity, or otherwise.
- (h) Examination of Records. Licensee agrees to keep accurate books of account and records covering all uses of the Data. USPS and its duly authorized representatives, which may include but not be limited to the USPS Office of Inspector General, the USPS Inspection Service, or any independent group or contractors procured by USPS to audit, shall with ten (10) days prior written notice have the right at all reasonable business hours not more frequently than twice (2) a year to examine such books and records in Licensee's possession or under its control with respect to the subject matter and terms of this Agreement, and shall have free and full access thereto for such purposes and for the purpose of making copies thereof. All such books and records shall be kept available for at least three (3) years after the termination or expiration of this Agreement. If Licensee or its representative confirms an audit field work appointment with the party conducting the audit, and such party is subsequently denied access to Licensee's books and records at such confirmed date and time for any reason, Licensee shall pay all reasonable costs and expenses incurred by such party in traveling to conduct such field work and any penalty imposed by the party.
- (i) Sovereign Immunity. LICENSEE acknowledges and agrees that this Agreement is subject to any legislation that might be enacted by the Congress of the United States or any orders or regulations that might be promulgated any agency, branch, or independent establishment of the United States Government. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary set forth herein, LICENSEE further acknowledges and agrees that this Agreement in no way waives the LICENSOR's authority to act in its sovereign capacity and that, pursuant to the sovereign acts doctrine, the

LICENSOR shall not be held liable for any acts performed in its sovereign capacity, or for any acts performed by any branch, agency or independent establishment of the United States in their sovereign capacities that may directly or indirectly affect the terms of this Agreement. In the event that LICENSOR or LICENSEE is required by legislation enacted by the Congress of the United States or any orders or regulations that might be promulgated by any branch, agency, or independent establishment of the United States Government to terminate, or otherwise as a result of such action is unable to perform its obligations under this Agreement, either Party may give notice of termination, which termination (nothwithstanding other provisions of this Agreement), will be effective immediately or the effective date of such requirement, whichever is later. In the event that this Agreement is terminated as set forth in this subsection or LICENSOR is enjoined from proceeding with this Agreement by any court of competent jurisdiction, LICENSOR will not be subject to any liability by reason of such termination or injunction.
