### Pre-MTAC Pulse Items

- (Chip) **Undocumented Warning 14** Update when this will be implemented?
  - Cat 14 is still scheduled to become assessable January 1, 2023
  - Phase II enhancements deployed on 8/27/22 introduced an issue with Cat 14 logic
  - Evaluating logic fix & deployment date
- (Chip) **Undocumented**– Undoc reporting window & scrubbing has been extended- is there consideration to eliminate undoc?
  - Undoc reporting is Seamless Acceptance process to validate payment
  - USPS has no plans to eliminate undoc reporting
- (James) **SEU4 error**– Mailers still experiencing connection server error when uploading files to P4 update on repairs?
  - Requested full summary and resolution date
- (James) **WG195 Update**–
  - Prioritizing items from WG195 to deploy system updates/changes beginning February 2023- depth open item info is reviewed biweekly on UG11.
- (James) **IMbA for Business Reply Postage Payment**
  - Functionality for QBRM with multiple MIDs to a single PO Box and a single permit imprint.
  - Webinar Request- Early November/December, will confirm date
- (Dale) **Hazmat: Review/discussion** on hazmat indicators (STC vs ECS):
  - Finalized FRN, will brief Industry at MTAC
- (Dale) **TASK TEAM 34 – Parcel Endorsement for UAA Parcels** Update on TT34 Recommendation (submitted March 2022)
  - QSG will be updated to reflect product changes
  - (Steve Jarboe)
- (Tom) **40 cent stamp for Marketers**– Availability?
  - Stamps will be available January 2023
- (Janine) **TED-C Approval Process**– Update
  - PCSC approval process will be retired anticipated late February 2023

# USPS Ship TEM

USPS Ship has a TEM environment to support shipper testing

- Shippers will need to contact USPS to enroll in USPS Ship TEM if not already enrolled in USPS Ship production
- Once enrolled in TEM, shippers can submit Shipping Services Files (SSFs) versions 1.6, 1.7 and 2.0 via DTS which will be automatically passed to USPS Ship
- **For results of file processing**
  - **Now** – Shippers can request their manifest pricing and errors/warning results
  - **Future** – Shippers will review their USPS Ship reports in TEM (date TBD)
- **Enhancement from eVS:** Shippers will receive their contract pricing in USPS Ship TEM
