Oscoda Plastics, a brand of Holcim Solutions and Products US, LLC, respects the privacy of our users and has developed this Privacy Policy to demonstrate our commitment to protecting your privacy. This privacy policy is intended to describe for you, as an individual who is a user of protect-allflooring.com, or any of our related sites, mobile applications, or other online services, the information we collect, how that information may be used, with whom it may be shared and your choices about such uses and disclosures.

We encourage you to read this Privacy Policy carefully when using our website or services or transacting business with us. By using our website, mobile applications or other online services, you are accepting the practices described in this Privacy Policy.

Information We Collect About You

We may collect and store any personal information you enter on our website or provide to us in some other manner, including personal information, comment or other submission you upload or post to the website. This includes identifying information, such as your name, address, e-mail address and telephone number; your likeness; and, if you transact business with us, financial information such as your payment method (valid credit card number, type, expiration date or other financial information). This information may be sent to our servers located in the United States.

Children's Privacy

Our services do not address anyone under the age of 13. We do not knowingly collect personal identifiable information from children under 13. In the case we discover that a child under 13 has provided us with personal information, we immediately delete this from our servers. If you are a parent or guardian and you are aware that your child has provided us with personal information, please contact us so that we will be able to take necessary actions.

Information Collected Automatically

We automatically collect information from your browser when you visit our website. This information includes your IP address, your browser type and language, access times, the content of any undeleted cookies that your browser previously accepted from us (see "Cookies" below), and the referring website address.

From time to time, we may release non-personally identifying information in the aggregate, for example, by publishing a report on trends in the usage of our website.

Cookies

When you visit our website, we may assign your computer one or more cookies to facilitate access to our site and to personalize your online experience. Through the use of a cookie, we also may automatically collect information about your online activity on our site, such as the landing pages you visit, the links you click and the searches you conduct within the site. Most browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually modify your browser setting to decline cookies. If you choose to decline cookies, please note that you may not be able to sign in or use some of the interactive features offered on our website.

SMS Text Messaging

Other Technologies

We may use standard Internet technology, such as web beacons and other similar technologies, to track your use of our site. We also may include web beacons in promotional e-mail messages or newsletters to determine whether messages have been opened and acted upon. The information we obtain in this manner enables us to customize the services we offer our website visitors to deliver targeted advertisements and to measure the overall effectiveness of our online advertising, content, programming or other activities.

How We Use the Information We Collect

In general, we may use information that we collect about you to:

- Deliver the products and services that you have requested;
- Manage your account and provide you with customer support;
- Perform research and analysis about your use of, or interest in, our products, services, and content, or products, services and content offered by others;
- Communicate with you by e-mail, postal mail, telephone and/or mobile devices about products or services that may be of interest to you;
- Develop and display content and advertising tailored to your interests on our site and other sites through third-party remarketing services;
- Enforce our terms and conditions;
- Manage our business, and/or
- Perform functions as otherwise described to you at the time of collection.

With Whom We Share Your Information

We want you to understand when and with whom we may share personal or other information we have collected about you or your activities on our website or while using our services.

Personal Information

We do not share your personal information with others except as indicated below, or when we inform you and give you an opportunity to opt out of having your personal information shared. We may share personal information with:

- Authorized service providers: We may share your personal information with our authorized service providers that perform certain services on our behalf. Other Situations

We also may disclose your information:

 exercise our legal rights; to defend against legal claims; or as otherwise required by law.
 In such cases, we may raise or waive any legal objection or right available to us, in our
 sole discretion.
- When we believe disclosure is appropriate in connection with efforts to investigate, prevent, report or take other action regarding illegal activity, suspected fraud or other wrongdoing; to protect and defend the rights, property or safety of our company, our users, our employees, or others; to comply with applicable law or cooperate with law enforcement; or to enforce our website terms and conditions or other agreements or policies.
- In connection with a substantial corporate transaction, such as the sale of our business, a divestiture, merger, consolidation, restructuring, reorganization or asset sale.
- We may share aggregated and non-personal information we collect under any of the
 above circumstances. We may also share it with third parties and our sister brands to
 develop and deliver targeted advertising on our websites and on websites of third
 parties. We may combine non-personal information we collect with additional nonpersonal information collected from other sources. We also may share aggregated
 information with third parties, including advisors, advertisers and investors, for the
 purpose of conducting general business analysis. For example, we may tell our
 advertisers the number of visitors to our website and the most popular features or

services accessed. This information does not contain any personal information and may be used to develop website content and services that we hope you and other users will find of interest and to target content and advertising.
