BETTER FAFSA UPDATE

BETTER FAFSA: Tim e lin e

MAR

- > MAR 4-11: FSA releases small batches of ISIRs to limited and selected schools, including CSAC.
- MAR 12: FSA releases 9-step temporary workaround for non-SSN contributors to complete FAFSA. Non-SSN contributors unable to use IRS FA-DDX to import tax info.
- > MAR 13: FSA begins sending larger ISIR batches to all schools and state agencies.
- MAR 14-24: Schools begin to report data discrepancies and high number of "unsub only" students

APR

- > APR 11: FSA updates several specification volumes to fix errors (technical specifications)
- > APR 15: Student-level FAFSA corrections are enabled
- > APR 17: FSA begins processing records with discrepant data resolving 5 issues
- > APR 30: FSA suspends identity validation process to allow non-SSN contributors to access FAFSA. IRS FA-DDX is still not functional. Tax information needs to be added manually.




> MAY 22: FSA makes additional updates to several specification volumes



- School-level corrections end of June
- Paper FAFSA processing end of June







Impacts to California

Delayed processing of initial Cal Grant awards

- Normally run in November
- 24/25 = early May 2024
- Initial run yielded 116,354 preliminary awards
- Additional ~16,000 awards by May 15 intent to enroll deadline

Decrease in FAFSA submissions (class of 2024)

- Approx. 13% decrease nationwide
- All 50 states are seeing a decrease (between 1% -21%)

College financial aid award letters delayed

- Difficult to make informed decisions
- Colleges unable to make corrections until late -June 2024
- Uncertainty (change in financial aid package?)

Enrollment declines?

- Long term impacts?
- If yes, how long to recover losses?

> MAR 25: state priority deadline extended from April 2 to May 2



- > APR 9: CADAA opened for first-time FAFSA filers from mixed status families
- > APR 15: Cal ISIR records delivered to campuses



- > MAY 1: CADAA opened for continuing/existing FAFSA filers from mixed status families
- > MAY 2: state priority deadline



- > JUN 7: Release of "AB 540 Affidavit" search screen in WebGrants
- > JUN 10: CADAA specifications updated to account for FSA update from April/May 2024
- > JUN 22: Cal ISIR records reprocessed and delivered to campuses

REMAINING DELIVERABLES (IN PROGRESS)

- > AB 540 School Report
- > AB 540 affidavit for students, attached to CADAA Submission Summary
- > CADAA College-level corrections
- > Processing of paper CADAA applications






RECAP: FSA ID CREATION

Non-SSN contributors can apply and receive a StudentAid.gov account (aka: FSA ID)

- ☐ Contributors are presented with knowledge-based verification questions via TransUnion match.
 - ✓ If successful FSA ID is authenticated and available to use immediately
 - ✓ If unsuccessful case # automatically assigned, manual ID verification required (Attestation Form, submission of ID documents)



FSA ID CREATION: CURRENT STATUS

Very few contributors without SSN have been able to confirm their identity, receive FSA ID

- Knowledge-based verification questions may not appear, leading to manual identity verification
- FSAIC contact center, experiencing long wait times, disconnected calls
- Delays in processing manual verification documents
- Expired documents not accepted for identity verification

U.S. Dept of Education: released <u>multi-step</u> "workaround"



CSAC Response

Created CADAA Pathway for FAFSA filers

- Target population = students with non -SSN contributors
- April 9, 2024
 - □ CADAA opened to High School students
 - ☐ Approx. 2,700 applications to date
- May 1, 2024
 - ☐ CADAA opened to Continuing Students
 - ☐ Approx. 470 applications to date

Benefits

- Alternative pathway for students to submit a financial aid application by state priority deadline
- Allows students to be considered for Cal Grant Entitlement awards and Middle-Class Scholarship
- Generate a Student Aid Index (SAI)
 - ☐ Shared with colleges the student selects
 - □ Colleges may utilize in fo to provide 'estimated' financial aid package
 - ☐ Provides some useful information for students and families as they make college enrollment decisions



ONGOING OUTREACH CAMPAIGNS

Targeted Outreach Campaigns

- On-time applicants with Rejected FAFSA/CADAA
 - ☐ Reassurance: deadline was met
 - □ Next step: review FAFSA/CADAA for errors
- CADAA filers with nonSSN FAFSA contributors
 - ☐ Clarity: what it means to have filed a CADAA
 - ☐ Guidance: StudentAid.gov account creation workaround
 - □ Next step: finish FAFSA to <u>maximize</u> financial aid consideration
- GPA on file but m issing FAFSA/CADAA
 - □ Identify issue: m issing FAFSA/CADAA
 - □ Next step: subm it FAFSA/CADAA
 - ☐ Inform: Cal Grant appeals process

WHAT WE KNOW



Public Comment Period

- ➤ Bypassed for 25/26
- ➤ Intent: Fast -track approval process
- ➤ Downside: does not allow public to provide input/feedback



Preliminary 25/26 documents

- ➤ No documents have been released by FSA
- ➤ No substantive changes for 25/26
- > FSA will continue to focus on user experience



Listening sessions with FSA

- Weekly listening sessions
- > Provide input on supports for students, families, institutions
- ➤ Identify pain points to address for 25/26



25/26 Launch Date

- ➤ October 1 st launch?
- ➤ No official announcement from FSA
- "Working towards" an October 1 st launch
- ➤ No further updates since <u>June 17</u> electronic announcement



FAFSA & CADAA Submission Trend Summary

- As of May 2nd deadline overall FAFSA/CADAA applications are down year over year and over two year period
- Applications from high school seniors are down year over year across all higher education segments.
- Largest declines at for-profits and CCC (but CCC declines have been shrinking).
- Dream Act applications are down year over year (multi year trend)
- 'On time' applications were up compared to last year's deadline
- Applications to date (June) are still down but YoY gap has been decreasing. Close to where we were in 2022


