- Students **with IGETC** must complete the full Mathematics and Natural Science requirements only.
- Students **with Partial IGETC** must complete the Mathematics and Natural Science requirements as well as any missing area(s) to satisfy IGETC.
- Students **without IGETC** must complete all of the GE requirements listed below.
- Revelle College does not accept **UC Letters of Reciprocity**. These students must complete all GE requirements.

<i>Met with IGETC</i>	<p>Humanities (<i>Letter Grade</i>)</p> <p>A five-course sequence is required: HUM 1 (winter) → HUM 2 (spring) → HUM 3 (fall) → HUM 4 (winter) → HUM 5 (spring)</p> <p>*Effective Fall 2024, all new transfer students will be required to take HUM 100</p>
<i>Required for all Students</i>	<p>Mathematics (<i>Letter Grade</i>)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ 2 semesters of Calculus; or ○ 1 quarter of Calculus (MATH 10A/20A); and 2 courses selected from MATH 10B/20B, 10C/20C, 11, 18, DSC 10, PHIL 10, or PSYC 60
<i>Required for all Students</i>	<p>Natural Science (<i>Letter Grade or P/NP, depending on major requirements</i>)</p> <p>Five courses in Natural Sciences, to include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ 1 course in Biology (BILD 1, 2, 3, 5, 7, 10, 12, 18, 20, 22, 26, 28, 30, 32, 36, 38, 42, 44, 46, 51, 60, or 61) ○ 1 course in Chemistry (CHEM 4, 6A-C, 6AH-6CH, or 11) ○ 1 course in Physics (PHYS 1A-1C, 2A-2D, 4A-4E, 5, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, or 13) ○ 2 courses from Biology, Chemistry, Physics lists above, or from additional list: ESYS 10, SIO 1, 3, 10, 12, 15, 16, 20, 25, 30, 35, 40, 50, 60, or PHIL 12 <p>*Effective Fall 2024, all new transfer students will be required to take four courses in natural sciences</p>
<i>Met with IGETC</i>	<p>Social Science (<i>Letter Grade</i>)</p> <p>Two courses (4-units each; upper or lower division) selected from the list of approved departments. Upper division courses may not overlap with major requirements.</p>
<i>Met with IGETC</i>	<p>Fine Arts (<i>Letter Grade or P/NP</i>)</p> <p>One course (2-4 units) selected from Music, Theatre, Dance, or Visual Arts. Upper division courses may not overlap with major requirements.</p>
<i>Met with IGETC</i>	<p>Foreign Language (<i>Letter Grade or P/NP</i>)</p> <p>Proficiency demonstrated by exam or completion of a fourth quarter or third semester (intermediate level) course.</p>
