The selected candidate will be key in improving and scaling the SBTi website, guaranteeing a secure web experience, and will also contribute to the development of the technical architecture of the SBTi digital platforms.

Key Responsibilities

- Work with the Data & Technology Team to deliver updates to the custom Python Web application supporting the company's submitting emission target validations.
- Support the in-house development team in the management and continuous improvement of the SBTi website, working closely with subject matter experts and content leads to implement regular updates and enhancements.
- Support the continuous improvement of the website and digital platforms, including content and performance, in line with user needs and developing business priorities;
- Manage relationships with digital agencies to ensure maintenance of software and infrastructure, security, and optimal performance of the website and digital platforms;
- In collaboration with IT security, design a robust and secure web experience protecting critical back-end data;
- Integrate API calls between the web back-end and data applications to ensure the accurate display of relevant information on the website.
- Translate design mockups and prototypes into functional, responsive, and accessible web pages using HTML, CSS, and JavaScript.
- Leverage content management systems (e.g., Craft CMS) to efficiently manage the website's content and structure.
- Stay up-to-date with the latest front-end technologies, frameworks, and best practices, and implement them to improve the website's user experience and maintainability.
- Work independently and as part of a team to deliver high-quality web solutions within agreed timelines.



Essential Skills & Experience

- Proficient in modern front-end technologies, and responsive web design, including HTML, CSS, JavaScript, and familiarity with libraries, such as React, Angular, or Vue.js
- Hands-on experience with Content Management Systems, particularly Craft-CMS.
- Strong understanding of web standards, accessibility, cross-browser compatibility, and the ability to translate design concepts and wireframes into functional, pixel-perfect user interfaces.
- Familiarity with version control systems (e.g., Github/Gitlab) and collaborative development workflows.
- Ability to work remotely and flexibly in a global environment with limited direct supervision
- Familiarity with agile values and how to leverage agile to adapt to change and perform effectively under pressure, experience using Asana a plus;
- Strong written and oral communication skills, and advanced English level for nonnative speakers

- Knowledge of Figma and dev tools for seamless collaboration with the design team.
- Experience integrating with RESTful APIs and handling data exchange in formats like JSON.
- Knowledge of maintenance, scaling, migrating, and deploying your code on different platforms most especially GCP using Kubernetes, Cloud run, and/or App engine.
