Search Warrants Executed in August 2019

There were 3 search warrants that were executed simultaneously at 9:00am on Wednesday, August 14, 2019 in Austin, Texas. Copies of the actual search warrants were not given to any of the parties present at any of the 3 search locations, and no copy of the search warrant was left behind after the completion of the searches.

The only way copies of the search warrants were received were by emails from AUSA Alan Buie to counsels.

Since the search warrants were sent as PDF files via email after the searches, we were able to analyze the metadata of the PDF documents that were emailed.

According to the filings with the court in the Western District of Texas, each of these search warrants was signed and issued by Magistrate Judge Mark Lane at 10:00am on Monday, August 12, 2019.

- Search warrant returns and inventories signed by Rani Sabban contain false statements for all 4 of the executed search warrants.
- Kevin Knebel sworn testimony under oath contradicts the government's filings for the search warrant, return, and inventories.
- · Grand Jury Subpoena served on Kevin Knebel by Alan Buie date irregularities.
- use of personal cell phone in all communications with Kevin Knebel re: Contego search.
- Contego phone records show extensive communication after the searches to coordinate stories between Joy, and Kevin Knebel.

Western District of Texas - Orders and Docket Irregularities

- There are many inexplicable changes that were made to the docket by
 atypical and do not follow the normal path.
- · These changes to the docket call in to question manipulation of documents and filings.
- Irregularities in the signatures by Magistrate Judge Lane for Orders signed.
- Wrong documents given to Gerry Morris on 10/21/2019 and Michael Wynne on 2/28/2020.
- Documents provided by Court on 10/21/2019 did not have PACER numbers atop the header, which is
 inconsistent with documents filed by the Court and printed from their system.
