## REITERATION OF ORDERS OF THE COURT

On July 12, 2023, the court issued a Discovery Order, in which it ordered the House Board of Managers to produce, permit the inspection of, and disclose certain information. On July 17, 2023, the court ordered the parties to not publicly furnish "information received pursuant to the Discovery Order[.]" At this time, the court does not find that any additional conditions are necessary to prevent the public disclosure of confidential information contained within documents produced or disclosed pursuant to the Discovery Order.

Accordingly, the court expects the House Board of Managers to continue production of information pursuant to the Discovery Order without requiring any additional conditions or caveats regarding the public release of the information. The court further expects Warren Kenneth Paxton, Jr., and his attorneys and agents to not publicly furnish information received pursuant to the Discovery Order.
