Theatre and Dance Double Major

The double major in Theatre and Dance provides students with a solid academic and an artistic base in both theatre and dance disciplines. Furthermore, requirements for this double major will create stronger and more experienced directors (for their exposure to choreography), choreographers (for their exposure to directing), actors (for the poise and strength they will attain from dance), and dancers (for having confronted text and character).

A Theatre and Dance double major cannot be declared until a student completes at least 90 units and no more than 135 units. Students should meet with the department's undergraduate coordinator as soon as possible to create an academic plan to work towards the double major. Students have the opportunity to perform in the Theatre and Dance Departmental productions and receive academic credit. The Theatre and Dance productions are held in the Theatre District shared with the Tony award-winning La Jolla Playhouse.

Incoming Freshman pursuing a Theatre and Dance double major may submit an <u>optional</u> art portfolio/audition video to enhance their overall UCSD application. However, a double major cannot be declared on UCSD's application students will need to either select Theatre OR Dance as their preferred major. Double majors can only be declared once a student is officially accepted into UCSD and reaches 90 units. Transfer students and current UCSD students do not have to submit an audition video to be a Theatre and Dance double major.

A total of 29 courses/116 units are required for the Theatre and Dance double major. Courses taken for the major must be taken for a letter grade and only grades of "C-" or better will be accepted.
