<u>Step 1</u>: Search for courses offered by the university you wish to attend abroad

DISCUSS



Step 2: Meet with your major/college advisors to see if those courses can be applied to your UCSD requirements

PETITION



Step 3: When you return from abroad, petition your classes to count towards your UCSD requirements

<u>Tip</u>: When you return from abroad, bring back all your academic work (syllabi, tests, homework, etc.) to submit with your petition. Study abroad courses are not automatically counted towards major/college requirements.

Be sure to meet with your major/college advisors about your course selection before going abroad.
