



***2017 Treaty Event:
Promoting Multilateral Treaties that Safeguard Humanity
Daily Report***

Tuesday 19 September 2017

Today ten (10) **treaty actions** were effected with the Secretary-General by five (5) States; one (1) State participated at the level of **Head of Government** and four (4) States participated at the **ministerial level**.

There were a total of two (2) acceptances, four (4) accessions, and four (4) ratifications. A breakdown of the treaty actions is provided below:
