2024 - Fair Haven 55, North Country 50

After trailing 17-2 to start game and 30-18 at half, the Slaters used 12-1 run final 4:40 of 3rd for 38-37 lead .. Teams traded leads in 4th until Maddy Perry 3-pt FG with 1:24 left for 50-48 Slater lead (3 free throws for 53-48 lead :14 left) ... **Izzy Cole** 19 points and **Kate Hadwen** 12 points for Slaters, while **Sabine Brueck** had 14 points, 15 rebounds for Falcons

2023 - North Country 47, Spaulding 42

Trailing 23-16 at half, North Country outscored Tide 31-19 in 2nd half to cap off 24-0 season ... Falcons trailed 32-31 after 3rd, but took lead with 5 minutes left and then hit 7-of-8 FTs (12-of-14 overall) ... **Sabine Brueck** 12 of 16 points in 2nd half (4-for-4 at line final 24 seconds) and **Cora Nadeau** 13 points ... **Yvonne Roberge** had 11 points for Spaulding

2022 - Mt. Abraham 36, Spaulding 33

After Spaulding used an 11-0 run in 2nd quarter for an 18-16 lead at halftime and 25-21 lead after 3 periods, Mt. Abraham opened the 4th quarter with a 9-0 run for a 30-25 advantage and built lead to as many as 7 before Spaulding cut deficit to 3 with 3:15 left ... **Madison Gile** led the Eagles with 16 points, while **Emily Poulin** had 9 points to pace Spaulding

2021 - North Country 49, Fair Haven 38

The Falcons won their 1st-ever state title using a 13-2 run in 2nd half to open up 39-23 lead early in 4th quarter (Fair Haven got within 9 with 3:27 left) ... Falcons led 19-12 at half ... **Cora Nadeau** led North Country with 13 points, while **Riann Fortin** added 12 and **Mckenna Marsh** 11 ... **Ryleigh Colutti** led the Slaters with 17 points (9 in the 4th)

2020 - Fair Haven-Harwood (cancelled, virus)

Fair Haven and Harwood named co-champs due to Covid-19

2019 - Fair Haven 38, Lake Region 31

Ryleigh Colutti scored 13 of game-high 19 points in 1st half and hit 4 3-pointers to lead Slaters to state title ... Fair Haven used 8-0 run to open 2nd half for 32-22 lead, but Lancers cut deficit to 32-30 mid 4th before Slaters 6 free throws to clinch victory ... **Courtney Brewster** 6 points and 10 rebounds for Fair Haven, while **Tia Martinez** 10 points for Lake Region.

2018 - Mt. Abraham 33, Fair Haven 25

Mt. Abraham opened up 26-17 lead early in the 4th quarter before Fair Haven 8-1 run cut deficit to 27-25 with 1:10 left, but the Eagles got a layup and 4 free throws in final minute to secure their 3rd title in 6 years ... **Emma Carter** and **Jalen Cook** 9 points each to lead Mt. Abraham, while **Kaleigh Brown** all 11 of her points in 2nd half for Fair Haven.

2017 - Lyndon 40, Mill River 15

Lyndon won its 1st-ever state title while holding Mill River to 0 points in 2nd quarter and 2 points in 4th ... Lyndon ran out to an 8-0 lead before leading 19-6 at halftime and 34-13 after 3 periods ... **Madalyn Sanborn** scored 13 points while **Zea Macris** (8 rebounds) and **Emma Corey** 6 points apiece ... **Rylee Nichols** 5 points and 6 rebounds for Mill River.

2016 - Fair Haven 44, Mill River 29

Fair Haven won its 1st-ever state title, using a 13-5 run for a 24-12 lead late in 2nd quarter and an 8-2 run for a 35-20 lead midway thru the 3rd quarter ... Fair Haven led 37-25 after 3 quarters ... **Alexis Quenneville** had 16 points to lead Fair Haven, while **Nicole McCardle** and **Adriana Dalto** 7 each ... **Rylee Nichols** had 9 points and **Haley Hull** 7 for Mill River

2015 - Mill River 50, Lake Region 46

Mill River won its 1st-ever state title, snapping a 46-46 tie with 4 free throws in final 57.5 seconds ... Lake Region led 35-34 after 3 quarters before Mill River took 44-40 lead with 4:25 left ... **Ella Bankert** led Mill River with 14 points, including 8 in 4th, while **Carly Ward** added 10 points, while **Emily Lawson** 12 points and **Tyrah Urie** 11 for Lake Region.

2014 - Mt. Abraham 43, Fair Haven 30

The Eagles jumped out to 19-4 lead midway through the 2nd quarter and went on to win 2nd straight title ... Fair Haven cut deficit to 22-12 at half and 29-22 after 3 quarters, but got no closer ... **Meg Livingston** had 14 points for Mt. Abraham, while **Isabel Brennan** and **Sam Driscoll** added 10 apiece ... **Elizabeth Fyles** had game-high 18 points for Fair Haven.

2013 - Mt. Abraham 44, BFA-Fairfax 28

The Eagles broke open a 9-point game early in the 4th quarter with a 13-2 run for a 39-19 lead with 4:20 left in game ... **Isabel Brennan** had 16 points and 9 rebounds to lead Mt. Abraham, including 6 points during the 13-2 run ... **Meg Livingston** added 9 points for the Eagles, while **Brooke Naylor** had 9 points and 11 rebounds to lead BFA-Fairfax.

2012 - Hartford 48, Mt. Abraham 35

Hartford held the Eagles without a field goal for over a 12-minute stretch as the Hurricanes increased a 5-point 2nd quarter lead to an 18-point lead early in the 4th quarter ... **Sarah Illingworth** led Hartford with 13 points (12 in 1st half) and grabbed 17 rebounds, while **Stephanie Grobe** had 12 points ... **Ashlie Fay** had 14 points to lead Mt. Abraham.

2011 - Lamoille 50, Mt. Abraham 42

Mt. Abraham led 12-8 when Lamoille went on an 18-0 run and built a 34-15 lead at halftime ... The Lancers led by as many as 24 (41-17) and as little as 8 points (45-37) in the 2nd half ... **Chelsea Dunham** had 13 points (11 in 1st half) and 8 rebounds for Lamoille, while **Katie LaFreniere** added 12 points ... **Jen Loyer** had 12 points for Mt. Abraham.

2010 - Lamoille 62, Milton 49

Chelsea Dunham scored 13 of her game-high 32 points in the 4th quarter as the Lancers rallied from a 7-point deficit late in 3rd quarter ... Milton led 36-29 with 2:30 left in 3rd when Lamoille scored final 5 points of period and 25-5 run to start 4th for a 59-41 late in the game ... **Stephanie Bull** had 19 points and **Kaitlin Geary** had 12 points for Milton.

2009 - Burr & Burton 51, Lamoille 43

Burr & Burton built a 16-point lead in 3rd quarter and held off a Lamoille 11-0 run that helped cut deficit to 4 points in 4th quarter ... **Jenna Hoffman** had 15 points (11-of-12 free throws) and **Logan Cavanaugh** 12 points for Burr & Burton ... **Chelsea Dunham** had 16 points, all in the 2nd half, and 13 rebounds for Lamoille, while **Rachel Wellman** 15 points.

2008 - Milton 42, Lamoille 38

Milton built a 14-point lead early in 3rd quarter, but hit just 4-of-18 free throws in 4th quarter to allow Lamoille to cut deficit to 40-38 with 1:20 left ... Milton had used a 12-1 edge in 2nd quarter for a 26-14 halftime lead ... **Ashleigh Adams** and **Heather Little** both had 10 points for Milton, while **Rachel Wellman** 15 points and 12 rebounds for Lamoille.

2007 - Lamoille 41, Mt. Abraham 32

MSJ cut deficit to 30-24 late in 3rd quarter before Vergennes pulled away in 4th ... **Mandy Scott** added 11 points and 7 rebounds for Vergennes ... **Liz Forte** and **Natalie Marchese** both had 12 points for MSJ.

2005 - Vergennes 51, Randolph 39

Vergennes used an 11-3 run to end the 3rd quarter with a 34-27 advantage and held on in the 4th quarter to win its 1st-ever state title ... **Mandy Smith** 11 points and 10 rebounds for Vergennes, while **Heather Bedard** and **Amy Barrows** chipped in with 10 points apiece ... **Tomo Shimabukaro** had 13 points and **Anna Reis** added 9 points to lead Randolph.

2004 - U-32 53, Mt. Abraham 30

After an 18-18 tie at halftime, U-32 outscored Mt. Abraham 35-14 in the 2nd half for the 23-point victory ... Raiders used a 16-7 edge in the 3rd quarter and 19-7 in 4th ... **Julie Gall** scored 22 points and grabbed 9 rebounds for U-32, while **Chelsea Katzenberg** had 10 of her 13 points in the 1st half ... **Steph Bell** 10 points and 11 rebounds for Mt. Abraham.

2003 - Montpelier 60, Oxbow 59

Christine Aldrich's free throw with just 13.6 seconds left snapped 59-59 tie and clinch state title for Solons ... Oxbow jumped out to early 15-point lead, but Montpelier cut deficit to 32-28 at half ... Aldrich led Montpelier with 19 points, while **Lindsay Graff** added 18 points and 13 rebounds ... **Corinna Martino** had 16 points and 9 rebounds for Oxbow.

2002 - Oxbow 60, Montpelier 45

Kagan Prouty scored a game-high 16 points, including 10 straight points midway through the 2nd half to lead Oxbow to its 1st state title since 1993 ... **Felicia Garrett** chipped in 13 points for the Olympians, who led 24-22 at halftime ... **Christine Aldrich** had 12 points to lead Montpelier, while **Lindsay Graff** 8 points and 11 rebounds for the Solons.

2001 - Bellows Falls 51, Fair Haven 48

Dani Rayner scored 11 of her 23 points in the 4th quarter as the Slaters rallied from a 41-36 deficit after 3 quarters with a 13-4 run in the final period ... **Jevy Rayner** added 15 points for the Terriers ... **Kim Sweeney** game-high 28 points for Fair Haven and had a 3-pointer with 56 seconds left to cut deficit to 49-48, but Terriers 3 turnovers in final minute.

2000 - Bellows Falls 37, Fair Haven 20

Dani Rayner scored 13 of her game-high 16 points in the 1st half as the Terriers scored the final 5 points of the 2nd quarter for a 19-14 lead at break ... Bellows Falls increased its lead to 27-18 after 3 quarters and then outscored Slaters 10-2 in 4th quarter ... **Christina Holton** added 10 points for Bellows Falls, while **Kim Sweeney** 9 points for Fair Haven.

1999 - Milton 60, Montpelier 37

The Yellowjackets used a 16-4 run at the end of the 3rd quarter to increase a 2-point lead to a 39-25 advantage, then **Liz LeFebvre** scored 14 of game-high 22 points in 4th quarter ... **Latoy Berry** added 17 points, 8 rebounds and 7 steals for Milton, while **Rachel Roberts** 11 points ... **Erin Bressette** 13 points for Montpelier, which committed 49 turnovers.

1998 - U-32 56, Milton 39

Hilary Goodrich had 21 points and 10 rebounds to lead U-32 to its 1st state title ... Milton missed 30-of-34 shots in 1st half and trailed 30-12 at break, but cut deficit to 39-27 after 3 periods and 8 points, 41-33, with 5:30 left ... **Penne Dodge** added 16 points for U-32 ... **Liz LeFebvre** had 15 points and 13 rebounds for Milton, while **Missy Provost** had 13 points.

1997 - Mt. Abraham 78, Bellows Falls 54

Rachel Bryan scored 26 points and grabbed 10 rebounds as the Eagles jumped out to a 27-16 lead after 1 quarter and 50-24 at half, while closest the Terriers were able to cut deficit was 60-45 with 6:20 left in 4th quarter ... **Carolynne Erwin** added 18 points and **Casey Wedge** 14 for Eagles ... **Sara Lovell** 21 points and grabbed 15 rebounds for Bellows Falls.

1996 - Montpelier 53, Mt. Abraham 50

Carolynne Erwin had a game-high 21 points, while **Hope Allen** added 17 points and 12 rebounds as Montpelier used an 8-0 run late to take a 49-45 lead ... Abraham with 10 points, while **Rachael Bryan** had 9 points and grabbed 7 rebounds.

1993 - Oxbow 60, Bellows Falls 47

Carrie Smith scored a game-high 23 points, while **Jazz Huntington** added 19 points and 15 rebounds to lead the Olympians to an undefeated season ... Gretchen Pembroke hit a jumper from top of the key with 2 seconds left to give the Solons the 1-point victory in game that featured 9 lead changes in the 4th quarter ... Montpelier led 56-52 when Oxbow scored 5 straight points for a 57-56 lead ... **Jayme Yarger** and **Beth McBroom** 17 points apiece for Montpelier, while **Joy Weinrich** 23 points for Oxbow.

1989 - Bellows Falls 54, Fair Haven 50 (2ot)

Vickie Barry had 19 points, 18 rebounds and 9 blocked shots, while **Tatha Wells** had 14 points including tying free throw with 23 seconds left in OT and then all 6 Terrier points in 2nd overtime ... Fair Haven basket had tied game 44-44 with 25 seconds in 4th ... **Julie Wright** had 19 points and 11 rebounds for Slaters, while **Mary Kay Lanthier** 11 points.

1988 - Randolph 82, Oxbow 68

Jen Niebling led 5 Randolph players in double figures with 27 points as the Ghosts snapped Oxbow's 3-year title reign despite a 40-point performance from **Jade Huntington** (16-of-35 from field) ... Oxbow led 36-34 at half, but Randolph outscored the Olympians 27-19 in 3rd for 6-point lead and then used a 10-1 run in the 4th quarter for a 71-58 advantage.

1987 - Bellows Falls 62, Montpelier 61

The Terriers used a 12-6 run late in the 4th quarter to take a 62-57 lead with 1:20 left, then held on for the win after Montpelier scored 4 straight points and had 2 shots for the win in the final seconds ... **Peg Petraska** had 17 points to lead Bellows Falls ... **Shannon Babcock** had a game-high 24 points for Montpelier, while **Maggie Whitney** added 14.

1986 - Burr & Burton 49, Mill River 34

Sarah Mount scored 8 of her game-high 13 points in the 2nd quarter as the Bulldogs opened up a 26-14 halftime lead ... Burr & Burton built the advantage to 35-18 before a 7-0 Mill River run cut deficit to 10 points, closest they would get in 2nd half ... **Jessica Bell** and **Sue Geriak** 10 points each for Bulldogs, while **Lia Ackley** had 12 points for Mill River.

1985 - St. Johnsbury 73, Mill River 70 (3ot)

Tonia Rodd had 30 points and **Toni Rodd** added 19 as Hilltoppers rallied from 46-33 deficit in 3rd quarter to win 2nd straight title in 3 OT ... St. Johnsbury field goal with 2 seconds left tied game in 2nd OT and took final lead with 1:01 left in 3rd OT on Tonia Rodd free throws ... **Shaeneen Buckley** had 16 points and 13 rebounds for Mill River.

1984 - St. Johnsbury 55, Mill River 53 (ot)

Hilltoppers rallied from a 3-point deficit late in the 4th, then **Tonia Rodd** 2 straight field goals for St. Johnsbury 52-49 lead in OT and 2 foul shots for 55-51 lead with 17 seconds left ... **Tammy Armour** had 19 points for Hilltoppers, while **Rodd** 10 points and 14 rebounds ... **Lia Ackley** 19 points and 15 rebounds for Mill River, while **Stacy Eaton** 17 points.

1983 - Burr & Burton 48, Vergennes 40

Jennifer Roosevelt had 21 points and 16 rebounds to lead the Bulldogs to state title ... Burr & Burton led 20-18 at half before Roosevelt scored 10 points in the 3rd quarter and Bulldogs scored first 4 points of 4th period for 37-29 lead ... **Laurie Brunet** had 20 points and **Julie Charbonneau** 10 for Vergennes ... **Maria Dalton** 11 rebounds for Bulldogs.

1982 - St. Johnsbury 95, Vergennes 67

Karen Silloway had 35 points (17-of-28 from the field), 12 rebounds and 10 assists, while **Tammy MacLean** added 17 points (8-of-11 from field) and 12 rebounds as Hilltoppers scored 28 points in 2nd quarter for 47-30 lead and 30 points in 3rd period for 77-50 advantage ... **Lisa Mills** 17 points and 11 rebounds for Vergennes, while **Anne Barr** 12 points.

Oxbow led 37-32 early in the 4th ... **Karen Dwyer** 16 points and **Kathy Peterson** 10 for Oxbow.

1980 - Burr & Burton 61, Harwood 47

5 Bulldogs finished in double figures as Burr & Burton used a 12-0 run over the final 4 minutes of the 1st half to build a 39-21 halftime lead ... Harwood cut deficit to 45-36 after 3 periods, but Bulldogs scored 14 of 16 points in 4th from foul line ... **Karen Treat** had 14 points and **Kim Murphy** 13 for Burr & Burton, while **Pam Sprague** 16 points for Harwood.

1979 - Peoples 47, Harwood 39

Peoples snapped a 32-32 tie early in the 4th quarter with 7-0 run and hit 15-of-24 foul shots in final period, including 5-of-7 final 54 seconds to clinch title ... Harwood led 20-16 at half, but Peoples tied game 28-28 after 3 ... **Carleen Small** 14 points and **Carol Kelly** 11 to lead Peoples, while **Lori Moriarty** 11 points and **Mary Woodruff** 10 for Harwood.

1978 - Peoples 42, Randolph 39

Sharon Brown scored 10 of her game-high 20 points in 4th quarter to lead Peoples to its 1st-ever title ... Randolph led 14-13 at half before Peoples outscored Ghosts 15-10 in 3rd ... Brown scored 10 of Wolves 14 points in 4th, including 6 straight for 34-28 lead ... **Carol Kelly** added 12 points for Peoples and **Sue Montgomery** led Randolph with 13 points.

1977 - Randolph 45, Hazen 23

Pam Gray scored 11 of her 17 points in the 2nd period when Randolph outscored Hazen 18-7 for a 24-9 halftime lead ... The Ghosts increased the advantage to 32-12 as Hazen had just 2 field goals over the first 3 quarters (were 7-of-63 for game) ... **Janice Chapman** added 11 points for Randolph, while **Jackie Silver** had 8 points and 14 rebounds for Hazen.

1976 - Hazen 49, Randolph 47

Penny Libercent scored game-high 29 points, including the final 9 points for Hazen to rally from a 43-38 Randolph lead with less than 3 minutes left ... Hazen led 20-10 early in 2nd quarter, but Randolph used 22-10 run for 32-30 lead after 3 quarters ... **Elaine Farr** 10 points for Hazen, while twin sisters **Pam** and **Penni Gray** each had 13 points for Randolph.

1975 - Hazen 45, Oxbow 41

1973 - Oxbow 42, Milton 38

Mary Thomas had a game-high 16 points, including a go ahead basket with 30 seconds left before adding another field goal with 5 seconds left ... Oxbow led 19-13 at half and 27-26 after 3 periods before Milton took a 35-32 lead with 2:28 left ... Olympians finished game with a 10-3 run for the win ... **Mary Towne** had a team-high 12 points for Milton.

1972 - Oxbow 45, Hazen 29

Mary Thomas had 26 points and 18 rebounds as Oxbow led 7-0 after the 1st quarter and 19-3 at halftime to win the 1st Division 2 title ...
