2024 - West Rutland 48, Blue Mountain 37

Peyton Guay game-high 22 points to lead West Rutland to 3rd straight D4 title ... **Aubrey Beaulieu** added 11 points, while **Bella Coombs** 8 points and 14 rebounds for Golden Horde... **Olivia Cole Bugay** had 16 points to lead Long Trail, while **Molly Luikart** 10 rebounds ... West Rutland led 24-15 at half, 33-28 after 3 periods and 44-33 mid 4th

2023 - West Rutland 50, Blue Mountain 44

The Golden Horde capped a 23-0 season with **Aubrey Beaulieu** and **Arianna Coombs** both scoring team-high 13 points ... West Rutland was leading by 8 in 3rd period when the Bucks used 11-0 run to take 4-point advantage early 4th, but Golden Horde retook lead on 3-pointer and 3-point play ... **Felicity Sulham** 13 points and **Jordan Alley** 10 for Bucks

2022 - West Rutland 57, Proctor 56

9th and final lead change of 4th quarter was a **Anna Cyr** go ahead 3-pointer with just over 30 seconds left to give West Rutland to state title ... **Cyr** (5 rebounds, 5 steals) scored 13 of her 17 points in 2nd half, while **Peyton Guay** 15 points and **Isabel Lanfear** 9 rebounds ... **Maggie McKearin** 24 points and 5 steals for Proctor, while **Laci French** 12 points

2021 - Proctor over Danville (no-contest)

The championship game was not played and the state title was awarded to Proctor after Danville was unable to play in the D4 finals due to the Covid-19 virus state health protocols

2020 - Proctor-Mid VT Christian (cancelled, virus)

All 4 championship games were cancelled due to the Covid-19 virus ... Proctor and Mid-VT Christian named co-champs

2019 - West Rutland 39, Blue Mountain 33

Madison Guay broke 33-33 tie with 3-pointer with 1:26 left and West Rutland added 3 free throws final 17 seconds ... Golden Horde led 22-13 at half and 32-20 with 3:45 left in 3rd quarter before 11-0 Bucks run cut deficit to a 32-31 ... **Elizabeth Bailey** 12 points and **Kiana Grabowski** 10 to lead West Rutland ... **Lauryn Alley** 14 points for Blue Mountain

2018 - MSJ 39, Blue Mountain 21

After leading 9-7 after 1st quarter, MSJ outscored the Bucks 24-10 over the 2nd and 3rd periods combined to open a 16-point lead enroute to its 4th straight state title ... **Lyndsey Elms** led MSJ with 9 points, while **Angela Perry** (8 reb) and **Julia Lee** added 8 points ... **Emily Rappeno** hauled down 14 reb for MSJ, while **Lauryn Alley** 10 points for Bucks.

2017 - MSJ 50, West Rutland 36

MSJ won its 3rd straight title as the Mounties rallied from a 6-point deficit early in 2nd half with 7-0 run to take the lead as part of 21-4 run for 36-25 midway thru the 4th quarter ... MSJ went 22-for-36 from the foul line as **Jenna Eaton** led the Mounties with 17 points, while **Shannon Elms** added 11 points ... **Kelsey Wedin** had 12 points to lead West Rutland.

2016 - MSJ 42, West Rutland 36

Monica Schmelzenbach had a game-high 18 points, including 9-of-12 from free throw line in 4th quarter, to lead MSJ to 2nd straight title ... **Jenna Eaton** added 9 points for MSJ, which scored all 12 4th-quarter points at foul line ... MSJ led 25-17 at half and 30-23 after 3rd period ... **Brooke Raiche** had 12 points and **Kelsey Wedin** 11 for West Rutland.

2015 - MSJ 35, Proctor 29

MSJ never led by more than 6 points and snapped Proctor's 3-year reign as champion ... Proctor final 5 points of 3rd quarter to tie game 24-24, but MSJ 2 field goals from **Sally Hogan** (10 points) first 1:07 of 4th quarter for 4-point lead ... **Shannon Elms** had 10 point and 8 rebounds for MSJ, while **Olivia Valerio** 10 points and 5 rebounds for Proctor.

2014 - Proctor 40, MSJ 33

After trailing by 7 points at halftime, Proctor outscored MSJ 27-13 in 2nd half to win its 3rd straight state title ... **Abby McKearin** had 9 points, 7 rebounds and a 3-point field goal 45 seconds into 4th quarter to give the Phantoms the lead for good ... **Carly Trombley** added 9 points for Proctor, while **Monica Schlemzenbach** had game-high 11 points for MSJ.

2013 - Proctor 55, Arlington 38

Carrisa Elrick had 18 points and 7 rebounds to lead the Phantoms to their 2nd straight state title ... Proctor led 33-26 at halftime before holding Arlington to 12 points in the 2nd half ... **Jordan Mitchell** added 11 points and **Alyssa Valerio** 10 points for Proctor ... **Julia Lacoste** had 10 points and 9 rebounds for Arlington, while **Jennah Lacoste** had 9 points.

2012 - Proctor 61, Twinfield 52

After Twinfield had cut a 15-point halftime deficit to 45-40 early in the 4th quarter, Proctor used a 6-0 run to open up an 11-point lead with 3 minutes remaining ... **Mikayla Tanner** had 25 points and 14 rebounds for Proctor, while **Mikayla McCormack** 16 points and **Megan Carter** 10 ... **Bryanna Dupont** had 20 points and **Kaitlin Lyford** 10 for Twinfield.

2011 - Poultney 51, Arlington 31

Ali Jones scored a game-high 24 points to lead Poultney to its 1st-ever state title ... The Blue Devils used an 11-2 run in the 2nd quarter to take a 22-17 halftime lead and led 40-26 after 3 quarters ... **Jones** had 21 of her 24 points in the first 3 quarters, while **Kelly Festa** added 16 points and 14 rebounds ... **Cici Wade** led Arlington with 10 points and 11 rebounds.

2010 - West Rutland 55, South Royalton 40

Katie Lincoln had a game-high 20 points and **Brooke Griswold** added 17 points to lead West Rutland to its 2nd state championship ... The Golden Horde led 25-19 at half-time and used a 14-6 edge in the 3rd quarter to take a 41-25 lead heading into the 4th period ... **Shana Duffy** had 14 points and **Megan Whitcomb** 9 points for South Royalton.

2009 - Chelsea 47, West Rutland 41

Robyn Kennedy scored a team-high 21 points as Chelsea used a 10-3 run in 2nd quarter to open up 25-16 lead at half ... West Rutland cut the deficit to 37-33 at end of 3rd, but could get no closer ... **Morgan Tullar** added 8 points and **Whitney Ladd** 6 for Chelsea ... **Katie Lincoln** scored 21 of her game-high 23 points in the 2nd half for West Rutland.

2008 - Twinfield 51, Danville 50

Twinfield trailed 50-47 when **Vanessa Powers** cut deficit to 1 with 48 seconds left and, after Danville turnover, **Camille duPont** basket with 7 seconds remaining gave Twinfield the lead ... **Powers** had game-high 22 points and **duPont** added 17 ... **Naomi White** had 13 points and **Sam Burrington** 12 for Danville, which had led by 2 at half and after 3 quarters.

2007 - Danville 57, Twinfield 36

Danville jumped out to a 17-6 lead after the 1st quarter, 30-13 at halftime and then scored first 7 points of 3rd period to open up a 24-point lead ... **Naomi White** led Danville with 15 points, while **Eliza Wakefield** added 14 points and 11 rebounds ... **Michelle Kittredge** chipped in 12 points for the Indians ... **Camille duPont** scored 14 points for Twinfield.

2006 - West Rutland 51, Canaan 46

West Rutland won its 1st-ever state title as **Melissa Hughes** scored a team-high 17 points ... **Kristie Dunchus** added 10 points and 9 rebounds, while **Katie Jablonski** 10 points ... West Rutland used a 10-0 run in 2nd quarter for a 17-14 lead and led 44-37 before Canaan was able to cut the deficit to 44-41 late ... **Karissa Doyon** had 22 points to lead Canaan.

2005 - Chelsea 41, West Rutland 34

Michelle Smith scored 11 of her game-high 17 points in the 2nd half, including 5 straight points after West Rutland had cut Chelsea lead to 19-18 midway thru 3rd period ... Chelsea went 16-for-22 from the field (8-of-10 in 2nd half) to win 1st state title since 1986 ... **Mo Driscoll** added 9 points for Chelsea, while **Ashley Carlton** 12 points for West Rutland.

2004 - Wilmington 62, Danville 30

Lucy Sprung scored 25 points and grabbed 20 rebounds as Wilmington used a 16-4 edge in the 2nd quarter to open up a 30-14 halftime lead ... The Warriors outscored Danville 16-8 in both the 3rd and 4th quarters for the 32-point win ... **Corey Rusin** added 21 points for Wilmington, while **Jen White** and **Lindsay Calkins** both had 7 points for Danville.

2003 - Danville 53, Wilmington 50

Lauren Bertolini had 16 points, 9 rebounds and hit 6-of-6 free throws in 4th period, while **Karri Sicard** 14 points and 14 rebounds including 2 straight baskets for Danville 49-47 lead with 3:20 left ... **Lyndsay Calkins** added 14 points for Danville ... **Lucy Sprung** had 17 points and 8 rebounds for Wilmington, while **Corey Russin** 11 points and 7 rebounds.

2002 - Blue Mountain 69, Wilmington 63

Christine Perry had 26 points and **Danielle Restelli** added 20 points as Blue Mountain outscored Wilmington 19-9 over final 4:47 to erase a 54-50 deficit and complete undefeated season ... Bucks had a 46-37 advantage in 2nd half ... **Holly Scott** added 15 points for Bucks, while **Corey Rusin** scored 22 points and **Lucy Sprung** 12 points for Wilmington.

2001 - Danville 69, Wilmington 62 (ot)

Danville outscored the Warriors 12-5 in the overtime period after Wilmington had tied game 57-57 on a 3-point field goal with 6.2 seconds left in 4th ... Danville trailed by 7 before 8-0 run for 53-52 lead with 57 seconds left in 4th ... **Wendy Sicard** 18 points and **Kate Wakefield** 13 for Danville, while **Jamie Rosso** game-high 32 points for Wilmington in loss.

2000 - Danville 63, Canaan 60

Jessie Stevenson and **Lacy Ward** each scored 19 points as Danville snapped tie with 10-3 run for 60-53 lead with 1:56 left ... Canaan cut deficit to 62-60 with 25 seconds left ... **Emily Hoffer** added 14 points for Danville ... **Chantel McKeage** game-high 27 points, including 16 of Canaan's 18 points in 4th, while **Marissa Domanico** added 20 points.

1999 - Wilmington 46, Canaan 44

Jamie Rosso game-high 17 points, including go ahead layup with 10 seconds left and free throw with 3.4 seconds left after a steal ... Wilmington, which won 1st-ever state title and handed Canaan its 1st loss in 2 years, trailed 43-40 with 2:39 remaining before a 6-1 run ... **Alison Lima**, **Abigail Labrecque** and **Chantel McKeage** all 7 points for Canaan.

1998 - Canaan 64, Wilmington 55

In a battle of undefeated teams, Canaan led 49-48 with 5:10 left in the 4th quarter when they went on a 7-0 run to open up an 8 point lead ... **Marissa Domanico** had 23 points and 10 rebounds for Canaan, while **Angela Lepine** added 14 points and **Abigail Labrecque** 11 ... **Tammi Waters** had 23 points for Wilmington, while **Jamie Rosso** added 14 points.

1997 - Danville 71, Whitcomb 58

Marie Carpenter scored 20 of game-high 26 points in 2nd half after Indians had jumped out to 18-4 lead in 1st quarter ... Hornets cut deficit to 41-37 in 3rd quarter, but Danville led 52-43 after 3 ... **Abby Calkins** added 21 points and **Jill Stevenson** 14 for Danville ... **Stephanie Rhodes** had 18 points and **Jennifer Colton** had 15 points for Whitcomb.

1996 - Whitcomb 66, Danville 60

Whitcomb used a 16-1 run between the 3rd and 4th periods to win its 1st state title since 1972 ... Danville led by 3 points late in 3rd quarter when Whitcomb used the 16-1 run to take a 55-43 lead ... **Jen Colton** had game-high 20 points and **Stephanie Rhodes** 13 to lead Whitcomb, while **Abby Calkins** 20 points and **Marie Carpenter** 14 for Danville.

1995 - Canaan 65, Rochester 62

Samantha Hughes had game-high 24 points and **Courtnee Eary** added 22 points to lead Canaan to undefeated season ... After a 37-37 tie at halftime, Canaan opened up a 59-48 lead midway through the 4th before Rochester rallied to within 63-62 and had the ball with chance for lead in final minute ... **Corina Gendron** led Rochester with 21 points.

1994 - Canaan 55, Danville 46

Courtnee Eary had a game-high 18 points and **Kylee Eary** 10 points, including 3-pointer with 1:26 left for a 51-44 Eagles lead ... Canaan led 23-16 at half and 33-29 after 3 quarters, but Danville took a 35-34 early in 4th before a 6-0 run gave Canaan 46-41 lead .. **Kristin Wyand** had 17 points for Danville, while **Amy French** 9 points and 11 rebounds.

1993 - Danville 65, Canaan 49

Canaan led 27-25 at halftime, but Danville used a 24-10 edge in the 3rd quarter for a 49-37 Indians advantage and led by as many as 18 points in the 4th quarter ... **Kristin Wyand** led Danville with 18 points ... **Michelle Cote** had 16 points nad **Sandi Hughes** 14 points for Canaan, which had opened the game with 9-0 lead before a 16-2 Danville run.

1992 - Twinfield 47, Arlington 46

Annabel Khouri had a team-high 16 points, including a 3-point play with 1:38 left to snap a 44-44 tie ... Arlington got a pair of free throws with 42 seconds left, but missed a short jumper for the win at buzzer ... **Sally MacLaren** had 10 points for the Trojans, who won despite 36 turnovers ... **Diane Coffman** 18 points and 12 rebounds for Arlington.

1991 - Arlington 55, Twinfield 54

Bessie O'Dea had a game-high 25 points, including 2 free throws with 14 seconds left to give Arlington a 55-51 lead as Eagles repeated as champion and handed Twinfield 1st loss ... Arlington led 53-44 with 1:25 left before Trojans went on 7-0 run ... **Diane Coffman** 13 points and 12 rebounds for Eagles, while **Annabel Khouri** 17 points to lead Twinfield.

1990 - Arlington 52, Twinfield 34

The Eagles jumped out to a 24-14 lead at halftime before scoring first 13 points of 2nd half and took a 41-16 lead after 3 quarters ... Twinfield scored 18 of its 34 points in 4th period, including a 16-3 run that cut deficit to 44-32 with 3:06 left ... **Robie O'Day** had 19 points and **Bessie O'Dea** 12 for Arlington, while **Sally MacLaren** 14 points for Twinfield.

1989 - Twinfield 57, Stowe 48

Vanessa Khouri had 38 points and **Tanya Kowalski** (17 rebounds) added 16 points to combine for 54 of Twinfield's 57 in title-game win ... Trojans held Stowe to 2 points in 2nd quarter for 25-12 lead at half before Stowe cut deficit to 27-23 with 11-0 run ... Twinfield used a 15-5 run for 42-28 lead after 3 ... **Heidi Scheuermann** led Stowe with 22 points.

1988 - Danville 40, Stowe 34

Danville snapped 30-30 tie with 5:15 remaining in the game with 10-2 run for 40-32 lead with 1:13 left ... The Indians scored final 13 points of 1st quarter for 13-7 lead, but trailed 17-16 at half before taking a 27-24 lead after 3 quarters ... **Andrea DeLaBruere** 12 points and **Christi Incerpi** 10 for Danville, while **Heidi Scheuermann** 16 points for Stowe.

1987 - Stowe 38, Danville 35

Kristen Scheuermann had 15 points and 8 rebounds, while her sister **Heidi Scheuermann** added 12 points as Stowe used a 5-0 run in the 4th quarter to take a 35-28 lead with 3:30 left ... The Indians were able to cut the deficit to 35-31 with 1:24 remaining ... **Andrea DeLaBruere** scored 14 points, while **Christi Incerpi** had 13 points to lead Danville.

1986 - Chelsea 27, Stowe 25

Elizabeth Mesh had a game-high 12 points, including the go ahead field goal with 2:20 left for 26-25 lead ... The game was tied 13-13 at half before Stowe scored first 8 points in 3rd quarter, but Raiders went 1-for-15 from field rest of game as Chelsea cut deficit to 21-20 entering the 4th quarter ... **Heidi Scheuermann** had a team-high 8 points for Stowe.

1985 - Stowe 51, Chelsea 39

3 Raiders combined for 48 of Stowe's 51 points, including 21 points and 17 rebounds from **Jennifer Beck** ... Stowe's **Erica Nourigan** 16 points, while **Kristen Scheuermann** 11 points and 14 rebounds ... Stowe used 13-6 run in 2nd quarter for 24-22 lead at half and led 38-28 after 3 quarters ... **Karen Colby** 14 points and **Elizabeth Mesh** 12 for Chelsea.

1984 - Blue Mountain 48, Stowe 26

The Bucks outscored Stowe 10-6 in each of first 2 quarters for an 8-point halftime lead, then outscored the Raiders 15-8 in the 3rd period for a 35-20 lead ... **Connie Bixby** led Blue Mountain with 20 points, while **Debbie Slayton** added 11 points and 11 rebounds ... **Tracy Brych** had 14 points to lead Stowe, which was held under 10 points in all 4 quarters.

1983 - Chelsea 50, Twinfield 40

Trailing by 2 points at halftime, Chelsea outscored Twinfield 16-5 in 3rd quarter for 37-28 lead, then scored 11 of its 13 points in 4th period at foul line for 4th straight title ... **Jodie LaPan** (7 free throws in 4th) and **Karen Fitzgerald** both had 17 points for Chelsea ... **Beth Basile** had 14 points for Twinfield, while **Debbie Johnson** 9 points and 9 rebounds.

1982 - Chelsea 62, Blue Mountain 40

Karen Fitzgerald hit 15-of-21 shots from field, scored 34 points and grabbed 19 rebounds to lead Chelsea to its 3rd straight title ... The Red Devils led 38-33 late in 3rd before scoring final 4 points of quarter and outscored Bucks 20-7 in 4th ... **Edith Grassette** added 10 points and 16 rebounds for Chelsea, while **Sue Kendall** led Bucks with 12 points.

1981 - Chelsea 63, Richford 55

Chelsea built a 10-point lead after 1st quarter and led by as many as 24 with 3 minutes left in 3rd quarter, then held off a 23-3 Richford run that cut deficit to 56-52 with 3:10 left in the 4th period ... **Karen Fitzgerald** had a game-high 27 points for Chelsea, while **Edith Grassette** and **Lori Button** added 10 points ... **Angie West** led Richford with 25 points.

1980 - Chelsea 50, Richford 47

Chelsea outscored Richford 12-8 in both the 2nd and 3rd quarters for a 35-28 halftime lead, then led 43-32 with 5:21 left in 4th before Richford cut the deficit to 48-47 with 1:28 remaining and then missed shot for lead with 25 seconds left ... **Diane Fitzgerald** had 17 points and **Karen Fitzgerald** 15 for Chelsea, while **Angie West** led Richford with 16 points.
