Engage community members and partners to develop strategic plans and program workplans for the oral health program.

OBSERVATIONS & CHALLENGES



States are more likely to have plans if required by a funder



More states have a sustainability plan, and the percentage of states receiving 75-100% of funding from just one source has decreased



Few states have a quality improvement plan despite resources and training devoted to evaluation
