The stipend is 1750 PLN per month for 12 months. The starting date will be in fall 2024. The candidate will be working with dr. hab. Michał Michałowski on various topics on cosmic gas, galaxies, gamma-ray bursts, and/or supernovae.

Requirements:

- enrolment in the undergraduate programme (master studies having finished bachelor studies, or 4th or 5th year for a 5-year programme) at a university in Poland
- or enrolment in a PhD programme at a university in Poland
