Pursuant to Step 13 of the ISO Tariff 40.4.6.2.1, the California ISO will continue to accept two (2) requests for remaining import capability per calendar week from Scheduling Coordinators for Load Serving Entities or Market Participants in priority of the time requests are received.

All transfers and requests for assignment must be submitted in CIRA (under Plans > Manage Import Allocation > Remaining Import Capability > Remaining Import Capability Steps).
