## VESSEL REPAIR DUTIES FOR VESSELS ENTERING U.S. PORTS; CORRECTION

**AGENCY:** U.S. Customs and Border Protection; DHS.

**ACTION:** Final rule; correcting amendments.

**SUMMARY:** On July 29, 2022, U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) published a Final Rule in the **Federal Register** that streamlines the vessel repair entry process by extending the timeframe for vessel operators to provide completed vessel repair entries and to apply for relief from assessment of duties associated with vessel repairs occurring abroad. The rule now extends the timeframe from 90 days to 150 days and eliminates the need for filing extension requests. That document inadvertently deleted the list of evidence required in Applications for Relief from the assessment of vessel repair duties. CBP is correcting that error by restoring the list of required documentation in the regulations.

**DATES:** Effective August 19, 2022.

SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION: On July 29, 2022, U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) published a Final Rule in the Federal Register (87 FR 45642) that streamlines the vessel repair entry process by extending the timeframe for vessel operators to provide completed vessel repair entries and to apply for relief from assessment of duties associated with vessel repairs occurring abroad. The rule now extends the timeframe from 90 days to 150 days and eliminates the need for filing extension requests. The Final Rule inadvertently deleted the list of evidence required in Applications for Relief from the assessment of vessel

repair duties in the subparagraphs to 19 CFR 4.14(i)(1). CBP is correcting that error to restore subparagraphs (i) through (vi) in 19 CFR 4.14(i)(1).

## § 4.14 Equipment purchases for, and repairs to, American vessels

  - (1) \* \* \*
- (i) Itemized bills, receipts, and invoices for items shown in paragraph (e) of this section. The cost of items for which a request for relief is made must be segregated from the cost of the other items listed in the vessel repair entry;
- (ii) Photocopies of relevant parts of vessel logs, as well as of any classification society reports which detail damage and remedies;
- (iii) A certification by the senior officer with personal knowledge of all relevant circumstances relating to casualty damage (time, place, cause, and nature of damage);
- (iv) A certification by the senior officer with personal knowledge of all relevant circumstances relating to foreign repair expenditures (time, place, and nature of purchases and work performed);

- (v) A certification by the master that casualty-related expenditures were necessary to ensure the safety and seaworthiness of the vessel in reaching its United States port of destination; and
- (vi) Any permits or other documents filed with or issued by any United States Government agency other than CBP regarding the operation of the vessel that are relevant to the request for relief.

# REVOCATION OF THREE RULING LETTERS AND REVOCATION OF TREATMENT RELATING TO THE TARIFF CLASSIFICATION OF HOT & COLD WATER DISPENSERS

**AGENCY:** U.S. Customs and Border Protection, Department of Homeland Security.

**ACTION:** Notice of revocation of three ruling letters, and of revocation of treatment relating to the tariff classification of hot & cold water dispensers.

**SUMMARY:** Pursuant to section 625(c), Tariff Act of 1930 (19 U.S.C. § 1625(c)), as amended by section 623 of title VI (Customs Modernization) of the North American Free Trade Agreement Implementation Act (Pub. L. 103–182, 107 Stat. 2057), this notice advises interested parties that U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) is revoking three ruling letters concerning tariff classification of hot & cold water dispensers under the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States (HTSUS). Similarly, CBP is revoking any treatment previously accorded by CBP to substantially identical transactions. Notice of the proposed action was published in the *Customs Bulletin*, Vol. 56, No. 23, on June 15, 2022. Five comments were received in response to that notice.

**EFFECTIVE DATE:** This action is effective for merchandise entered or withdrawn from warehouse for consumption on or after November 6, 2022.

#### SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION:

#### BACKGROUND

Current customs law includes two key concepts: informed compliance and shared responsibility. Accordingly, the law imposes an obligation on CBP to provide the public with information concerning the trade community's responsibilities and rights under the customs and related laws. In addition, both the public and CBP share responsibility in carrying out import requirements. For example, under section 484 of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended (19 U.S.C. § 1484), the importer of record is responsible for using reasonable care to enter, classify and value imported merchandise, and to provide any other information necessary to enable CBP to properly assess duties, collect accurate statistics, and determine whether any other applicable legal requirement is met.

Pursuant to 19 U.S.C. § 1625(c)(1), a notice was published in the *Customs Bulletin*, Vol. 56, No. 23, on June 15, 2022, proposing to revoke three ruling letters pertaining to the tariff classification of hot & cold water dispensers. Any party who has received an interpretive ruling or decision (i.e., a ruling letter, internal advice memorandum or decision, or protest review decision) on the merchandise subject to this notice should have advised CBP during the comment period.

Similarly, pursuant to 19 U.S.C. § 1625(c)(2), CBP is revoking any treatment previously accorded by CBP to substantially identical transactions. Any person involved in substantially identical transactions should have advised CBP during the comment period. An importer's failure to advise CBP of substantially identical transactions or of a specific ruling not identified in this notice may raise issues of reasonable care on the part of the importer or its agents for importations of merchandise subsequent to the effective date of this notice.

In New York Ruling letters ("NY") B88990, dated September 22, 1997, NY R00569, dated August 6, 2004, and NY N283857, CBP classified hot & cold water dispensers in heading 8418, HTSUS, specifically in subheading 8418.69.01, HTSUS, which provides for "Refrigerators, freezers and other refrigerating or freezing equipment, electric or other; heat pumps, other than the air conditioning machines of heading 8415; parts thereof: Other refrigerating or freezing equipment; heat pumps: Other." CBP has reviewed NY B88990, NY R00569, and NY N283857 and has determined the ruling letters

to be in error. It is now CBP's position that hot & cold water dispensers are properly classified, in heading 8516, HTSUS, specifically in subheading 8516.79.00, HTSUS, which provides for "Electric instantaneous or storage water heaters and immersion heaters; electric space heating apparatus and soil heating apparatus; electrothermic hairdressing apparatus (for example, hair dryers, hair curlers, curling tong heaters) and hand dryers; electric flatirons; other electrothermic appliances of a kind used for domestic purposes; electric heating resistors, other than those of heading 8545; parts thereof: Other electrothermic appliances: Other."

Pursuant to 19 U.S.C. § 1625(c)(1), CBP is revoking NY B88990, NY R00569, and NY N283857 and revoking or modifying any other ruling not specifically identified to reflect the analysis contained in HQ H322878, set forth as an attachment to this notice. Additionally, pursuant to 19 U.S.C. § 1625(c)(2), CBP is revoking any treatment previously accorded by CBP to substantially identical transactions.

In accordance with 19 U.S.C. § 1625(c), this ruling will become effective 60 days after publication in the *Customs Bulletin*.

RE: Revocation of NY B88990, NY R00569, and NY N283857; Tariff classification of hot and cold water dispensers.

Dear Mr. Crago:

This ruling is in reference to New York Ruling Letter (NY) R00569, dated August 6, 2004, regarding the classification of a hot and cold water dispenser under the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States (HTSUS). In NY R00569, U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) classified the subject article in heading 8418, HTSUS, which provides for "Refrigerators, freezers and other refrigerating or freezing equipment, electric or other; heat pumps, other than the air conditioning machines of heading 8415; parts thereof." Upon reconsideration, CBP has determined that NY R00569 is in error. We have also reviewed NY B88990, dated September 22, 1997, and NY N283857, dated March 22, 2017, which classify substantially similar hot and cold water dispensers in heading 8418, HTSUS. As with NY R00569, we have determined that the tariff classification of the subject merchandise in these rulings is incorrect.

Notice of the proposed action was published in the *Customs Bulletin*, Vol. 56, No. 23, on June 15, 2022. Five comments were received in response to that notice. Three commenters expressed general support for the revocation. Another commenter noted that classifying the subject water dispensers in heading 8516, HTSUS, rather than in heading 8418, HTSUS, could have consequences for the application of Section 301 duties. While we acknowledge that this action may indeed affect the applicability of Section 301 duties, we are required to apply the tariff as written, without regard to the presence or absence of Section 301 duties. The final comment is addressed below.

#### **FACTS:**

In NY R00569, the subject merchandise is described as a thermoelectric desktop water dispenser, featuring a stainless-steel hot water tank, and a separate thermoelectric chamber for cold water. The unit is further described as having hot and cold switches, a removable drip tray, and a light-emitting diode (LED) indicator light. The water dispenser is compatible with a three or five gallon water bottle, which fits into the top of the unit.

In NY B88990, CBP described the "Dual Quick Water Dispenser" as a drinking water dispenser, providing cold water or hot water for coffee, tea or soup. The unit is further described as having a compression type refrigeration system and a band heater for hot water.

In NY N283857, the merchandise is described as water coolers, dispensing hot and cold water. Two models are designed to connect directly to a water supply, while four additional models rely on a water bottle. Cold water is produced by a reciprocating compressor, with coils mounted on the back of the unit to receive refrigerant circulated by the compressor.

#### ISSUE:

Whether water dispensers that both chill and heat water are properly classified in heading 8418, HTSUS, which provides for "Refrigerators, freezers and other refrigerating or freezing equipment, electric or other; heat pumps, other than the air conditioning machines of heading 8415; parts thereof" or in heading 8516, HTSUS, which provides for "Electric instantaneous or storage water heaters and immersion heaters; electric space heating apparatus and soil heating apparatus; electrothermic hairdressing apparatus (for example, hair dryers, hair curlers, curling tong heaters) and hand dryers; electric flatirons; other electrothermic appliances of a kind used for domestic purposes; electric heating resistors, other than those of heading 8545; parts thereof."

#### LAW AND ANALYSIS:

Classification under the HTSUS is in accordance with the General Rules of Interpretation (GRIs). GRI 1 provides that the classification of goods will be determined according to the terms of the headings of the tariff schedule and any relative section or chapter notes. In the event that the goods cannot be classified solely on the basis of GRI 1, and if the headings and legal notes do not otherwise require, the remaining GRIs 2 through 6 will then be applied in order. GRI 2(b) states that "the classification of goods consisting of more than one material or substance shall be according to the principles of rule 3."

GRI 3(a) provides that "the heading which provides the most specific description shall be preferred to headings providing a more general description." GRI 3(b) states, in pertinent part, that composite goods that cannot be classified by reference to GRI 3(a), are to be classified as if they consisted of the component that gives them their essential character. GRI 3(c) provides that when goods cannot be classified by reference to GRI 3(a) or 3(b), they are to be classified in the heading that occurs last in numerical order among the competing headings that equally merit consideration.

The following provisions of the HTSUS are under consideration:

- 8418 Refrigerators, freezers and other refrigerating or freezing equipment, electric or other; heat pumps, other than the air conditioning machines of heading 8415; parts thereof:
- 8516 Electric instantaneous or storage water heaters and immersion heaters; electric space heating apparatus and soil heating apparatus; electrothermic hairdressing apparatus (for example, hair dryers, hair curlers, curling tong heaters) and hand dryers; electric flatirons; other electrothermic appliances of a kind used for domestic purposes; electric heating resistors, other than those of heading 8545; parts thereof:

#### Section XVI, Note 3 states that:

Unless the context otherwise requires, composite machines consisting of two or more machines fitted together to form a whole and other machines designed for the purpose of performing two or more complementary or alternative functions are to be classified as if consisting only of that component or as being that machine which performs the principal function.

All three of the water dispensers under consideration are designed to dispense hot and cold water. In other words, they perform two complementary functions: a refrigeration function designed to chill water, and a heating function designed to heat water. They are composite machines, covered by Note 3 to Section XVI. In assessing whether the devices have a principal function, we note that although the three dispensers are configured differently (e.g., differing uses of tanks and different types of refrigeration or heating technology), the heating and cooling of water is accomplished in parallel. Likewise, there is no indication that either the refrigerating or the heating equipment housed within the subject dispensers is more robust or effective. As such, we conclude that neither the refrigeration function nor the heating function constitutes the "principal" function of the water dispenser.

The Explanatory Notes<sup>2</sup> to Note 3 to Section XVI provide:

#### (VI) MULTI FUNCTION MACHINES AND COMPOSITE MACHINES (Section Note 3)

In general, multi-function machines are classified according to the principal function of the machine.

Multi-function machines are, for example, machine-tools for working metal using interchangeable tools, which enable them to carry out different machining operations (e.g., milling, boring, lapping).

Where it is not possible to determine the principal function, and where, as provided in Note 3 to the Section, the context does not otherwise require, it is necessary to apply General Interpretative Rule 3 (c); such is the case, for example, in respect of multi function machines potentially classifiable in several of the headings 84.25 to 84.30, in several of the headings 84.58 to 84.63 or in several of the headings 84.70 to 84.72.

Turning, then, to GRI 3, it is clear that neither heading provides a more specific description of the merchandise: both headings describe only part of the water dispenser. Neither the refrigeration component, nor the heating component gives the water dispenser its essential character. Thus, the goods cannot be classified pursuant to GRI 3(a) or GRI 3(b). The hot and cold water dispensers are therefore classified pursuant to GRI 3(c), in the heading occurring last in numerical order among those which equally merit consideration, heading 8516, HTSUS, in this instance.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> One commenter, agreeing that the water dispenser is a composite machine pursuant to Note 3 to Section XVI, argues that the principal function of the machine is the tap or valve controlling the flow of water. As a result, the commenter asserts that the water dispenser is properly classified in heading 8481, HTSUS. We disagree. The tap and any valves comprising the inner piping of the water dispensers are merely components incorporated into the goods.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>2</sup> The Explanatory Notes (ENs) to the Harmonized Commodity Description and Coding System represent the official interpretation of the tariff at the international level. While neither legally binding nor dispositive, the ENs provide a commentary on the scope of each heading of the HTSUS and are generally indicative of the proper interpretation of these headings. See T.D. 89–80, 54 Fed. Reg. 35127, 35128 (August 23, 1989).

One commenter asserted that the water dispenser should be classified in heading 8479, HTSUS, pursuant to Note 8 to Chapter 84. Note 8 to Chapter 84 provides: "Subject to note 2 to this chapter and note 3 to section XVI, a machine the principal purpose of which is not described in any heading or for which no one purpose is the principal purpose is, unless the context otherwise requires, to be classified in heading 8479." Note 8 to Chapter 84 applies to headings of Chapter 84, and is "[s]ubject... to note 3 to section XVI." Because we are considering headings both Chapter 84 and Chapter 85, and because the water dispensers are composite machines of Note 3 to Section XVI, Note 8 to Chapter 84 is not applicable in this instance.

#### HOLDING:

By application of GRIs 1, 3(c) and 6, the water dispensers at issue in NY R00569, NY B88990, and NY N 283857 are classified in heading 8516, HTSUS, and are specifically provided for under subheading 8516.79.00, HTSUS, which provides for "Electric instantaneous or storage water heaters and immersion heaters; electric space heating apparatus and soil heating apparatus; electrothermic hairdressing apparatus (for example, hair dryers, hair curlers, curling tong heaters) and hand dryers; electric flatirons; other electrothermic appliances of a kind used for domestic purposes; electric heating resistors, other than those of heading 8545; parts thereof: Other electrothermic appliances: Other." The general, column one rate of duty for merchandise of subheading 8516.79.00, HTSUS, is 2.7% ad valorem.

Duty rates are provided for your convenience and are subject to change. The text of the most recent HTSUS and the accompanying duty rates are provided on the internet at www.usitc.gov/tata/hts/.

#### EFFECT ON OTHER RULINGS:

NY R00569, dated August 6, 2004, NY B88990, dated September 22, 1997, and NY N283857, dated March 22, 2017 are hereby REVOKED in accordance with the above analysis.

In accordance with 19 U.S.C. 1625(c), this ruling will become effective 60 days after its publication in the Customs Bulletin.

The Broker Modernization Working Group currently meets monthly with the expectation that recommendations will be developed and submitted for consideration at an upcoming COAC public meeting. As announced at the June 29, 2022, COAC public meeting, the USMCA Working Group is being reconvened, and will start to meet in the 4th quarter.

4. The Secure Trade Lanes Subcommittee will provide updates on the progress and plans for the Remote and Autonomous Cargo Processing Working Group and the Cross-Border Recognition Working Group, as well as provide an update on the recommendations presented in the previous quarter by the In-Bond Working Group. The Partnership Programs and Industry Engagement Working Group topics of discussion will include updates on the new focus areas the working group is pursuing relative to its recommendations last quarter related to the Forced Labor portion of the newly published Customs Trade Partnership Against Terrorism (CTPAT) Trade Compliance handbook. The Export Modernization Working Group will provide information and supporting documentation on its recommendation provided during the last public meeting, along with updates regarding the development of policies for industry and government partners regarding data collection and sharing in all modes for exportation of goods out of the United States.

# TRANSITION OF THE ELECTRONIC CERTIFICATION SYSTEM (eCERT) TO AN UPDATED VERSION (eCERT 2.0)

**AGENCY:** U.S. Customs and Border Protection, Department of Homeland Security.

**ACTION:** General notice.

**SUMMARY:** This document announces the transition of the Electronic Certification System (eCERT) to an updated version, eCERT 2.0, which will become the sole method for participating in the eCERT process. The updated version includes three new features that will enhance the existing system by implementing additional validations

that verify the authorized use of quota certificates. The use of eCERT 2.0 will allow for the decrementing of quota certificates to prevent those certificates from being overused. Participating countries will have enhanced querying capabilities to query and track actual certificate usage. Additionally, importers will be able to query their usage of the quota certificates via the Automated Broker Interface. In order to participate in eCERT 2.0, importers must provide the participating country with the Importer of Record (IOR) number in advance of filing an entry, and, in turn, the participating country must submit the IOR number as an additional data element of information within the transmission for eCERT 2.0. The transition to eCERT 2.0 will not change the tariff-rate quota or tariff preference level filing process or requirements. Importers will continue to provide the export certificate or certificate of eligibility numbers from the participating countries in the same manner as when currently filing entry summaries with U.S. Customs and Border Protection. The format of the export certificate and certificate of eligibility numbers will remain the same for the corresponding eCERT transmissions.

#### Background

The Electronic Certification System (eCERT) is a system developed by U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) that uses electronic data transmissions of information normally associated with a required export document, such as a license or certificate, to facilitate the administration of quotas and ensure that the proper restraint levels are charged without being exceeded. Foreign countries participating in eCERT transmit information directly or via a global network service provider to CBP's automated electronic system for commercial trade processing, the Automated Commercial Environment (ACE).

Specific data elements are transmitted to CBP by the importer of record (or an authorized customs broker) when filing an entry summary with CBP, and those data elements must match eCERT data from the foreign country before an importer may claim any applicable in-quota tariff rate of duty or the preferential duty rate under a tariff preference level (TPL). An importer may claim an in-quota tariff rate

or preferential duty rate when merchandise is entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption, only if the information transmitted by the importer matches the information transmitted by the foreign government. If there is no transmission by the foreign government upon entry, an importer must claim the higher over-quota tariff rate or most-favored nation (MFN) rate of duty. An importer may subsequently claim the in-quota tariff rate or preferential duty rate under certain limited conditions.

Currently, Australia, Uruguay, New Zealand, and Argentina are approved for the use of eCERT for transmitting export certificates for certain beef entries subject to the tariff-rate quota.<sup>4</sup> Additionally, Mexico is approved for the use of eCERT for transmitting certificates of eligibility for certain textile and apparel goods that are eligible for preferential treatment under a TPL.<sup>5</sup>

This document announces that the transition of eCERT to eCERT 2.0 will be operational as of September 25, 2022, and eCERT 2.0 will become the sole method for participating in the eCERT process at that time. As of that date, the below-mentioned enhancements will become operational for the transmission of export certificates for certain beef entries from Australia, Uruguay, New Zealand and Argentina, and for the transmission of certificates of eligibility for certain textile and apparel goods from Mexico.

The updated system will include three new features that will enhance the existing eCERT system by implementing additional validations that verify the authorized use of quota certificates. One of the enhancements will allow the eCERT system to decrement the usage

of quota certificates and prevent those certificates from being overused, and thus, provide CBP with better and more easily available awareness of the certificate usage. Secondly, participating countries will have enhanced querying capabilities to query and track actual certificate usage in eCERT 2.0. The third enhancement will be a new Automated Broker Interface (ABI) query which will enable importers to query their usage of quota certificates. Importers are expected to exercise reasonable care pursuant to 19 U.S.C. 1484 when filing entries and tracking their usage of quota certificates and the availability of a new query capability in eCERT 2.0 does not relieve importers of this responsibility.

In order to participate in eCERT 2.0, importers must provide the participating country with their Importer of Record (IOR) number in advance of filing an entry, and, in turn, the participating country will submit the IOR number as part of the eCERT transmission to CBP. The participating country will submit the IOR number as an additional data element of information within the single transmission message to eCERT 2.0.

At this time, CBP recommends that importers share the IOR numbers with their exporters in advance of September 25, 2022, to allow for participating countries to test the updated system with actual IOR numbers and avoid rejection of the transmission due to missing IOR numbers once eCERT 2.0 is deployed. In general, importers will need to provide the IOR numbers only once to the participating exporter or country (which should be no later than 30 days in advance of filing an entry), but importers should ensure that the exporter has the IOR number on file for future transmissions.

The transition to eCERT 2.0 will not change the tariff-rate quota or TPL filing process or requirements. Importers will continue to provide the export certificate or certificate of eligibility numbers from the participating countries in the same manner as when currently filing entry summaries with CBP. The format of the export certificate and certificate of eligibility numbers will remain the same for the corresponding eCERT transmissions.

When completing the release form, candidates must provide the following information: Full name, partial Social Security Number (SSN#), Date of Birth, Current Address, Email Address, Phone Number; as well as specifying the type of medical records to be released (hearing test results, vision test results, etc.).

This information is used by CBP as confirmation that the agency has the candidate's signed authorization to provide medically related records about the candidate. A copy of that signed authorization and the records released are retained within the candidate's preemployment file.

CBP Form 4455, *Certificate of Registration*, is used primarily for the registration, examination, and supervised lading of commercial shipments of articles exported for repair, alteration, or processing, which will subsequently be returned to the United States either duty free or at a reduced duty rate. The CBP Form 4455 may be required when a person, wishing to claim the status of a nonresident upon arrival for a short visit to the United States before returning abroad, imports articles free of duty under subheadings 9804.00.20, 9804.00.25,

9804.00.30, 9804.00.35, Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States (HTSUS) (19 U.S.C. 1202). It may also be used for the replacement of articles previously exempted from duty when the unsatisfactory articles are exported under the provisions 9804.00.75 and fall under the \$800 or \$1,00 exemption limits. The export and return of theatrical scenery, properties, motionpicture films and effects or tools of a trade occupation or employment of domestic or foreign origin must also be reported on CBP Form 4555. The CBP Form 4455, may also be required in any case in which CBP Form 4457 will not adequately serve the purpose of registration. CBP Form 4455 must be presented to CBP for examination of the articles and verification of the articles' description. After the official has signed the document, it will be returned to the applicant for signature, for presentation to CBP upon return to United States, and for subsequent reuse. #### **OPINION**

#### Choe-Groves, Judge:

Plaintiff Hyundai Steel Company ("Hyundai Steel") and Consolidated Plaintiff and Plaintiff-Intervenor SeAH Steel Corporation ("SeAH") (collectively, "Plaintiffs") challenge the final determination in the 2015–2016 administrative review of the antidumping duty order covering circular welded non-alloy steel pipe ("CWP") from the Republic of Korea ("Korea"). Circular Welded Non-Alloy Steel Pipe from the Republic of Korea ("Final Results"), 83 Fed. Reg. 27,541 (Dep't of Commerce June 13, 2018) (final results of antidumping duty administrative review; 2015–2016); see also Issues and Decision Mem. for the Final Results of Antidumping Duty Admin. Review of Circular Welded Non-Alloy Steel Pipe from the Republic of Korea; 2015–2016 ("Final IDM"), PR 314.1

Before the Court are the Final Results of Redetermination Pursuant to Court Remand ("Fourth Remand Results"), ECF No. 116–1, ordered in Hyundai Steel Co. v. United States ("Hyundai Steel IV"), 46 CIT \_\_\_, \_\_\_, Slip Op. 22–67 at 25–26 (June 15, 2022). No party filed comments contesting Commerce's Fourth Remand Results. For the reasons discussed below, the Court sustains the Fourth Remand Results.

#### **BACKGROUND**

The Court presumes familiarity with the facts and procedural history of this case and recites the facts relevant to the Court's review of the Fourth Remand Results. See Hyundai Steel IV, 46 CIT at \_\_, Slip Op. 22–67 at 5–8; see also Hyundai Steel Co. v. United States ("Hyundai Steel I"), 43 CIT \_\_, \_\_, 415 F. Supp. 3d 1293, 1295–1301 (2019); Hyundai Steel Co. v. United States ("Hyundai Steel II"), 44 CIT \_\_, \_\_, 483 F. Supp. 3d 1273, 1275–76 (2020); Hyundai Steel Co. v. United States ("Hyundai Steel III"), 45 CIT \_\_, \_\_, 531 F. Supp. 3d 1344, 1347–48 (2021).

In the *Final Results*, Commerce determined that a particular market situation in Korea distorted the cost of production of CWP. Final IDM at 3. Commerce also determined that it could quantify the amount of the distortion, and it made an upward adjustment to the cost of production of CWP based on the subsidy rate of hot-rolled steel coil. Id. (citing Countervailing Duty Investigation of Certain Hot-Rolled Steel Flat Products from the Republic of Korea, 81 Fed. Reg. 53,439 (Dep't of Commerce Aug. 12, 2016) (final affirmative determination), as amended, Certain Hot-Rolled Steel Flat Products from Brazil and the Republic of Korea, 81 Fed. Reg. 67,960 (Dep't of Commerce Oct. 3, 2016) (amended final affirmative countervailing duty determinations and countervailing duty orders)). Commerce then conducted a sales-below-cost test and disregarded certain sales made at prices below the cost of production, as adjusted. See Decision Mem. for the Prelim. Results of Antidumping Duty Admin. Review: Circular Welded Non-Alloy Steel Pipe from the Republic of Korea: 2015–2016 ("Prelim. DM") at 19–20, PR 275; Final IDM at 3 (noting that Commerce used the same calculation methodology for the respondents not selected for individual examination for the Final Results as explained in the Prelim. DM). Commerce calculated normal value from the remaining above-cost home market sales for mandatory respondents Hyundai Steel and Husteel. Prelim. DM at 20; Final IDM at 3.

In Hyundai Steel I, 43 CIT at \_\_, 415 F. Supp. 3d at 1301, the Court concluded that Commerce's particular market situation determination was unsupported by substantial evidence. In the Final Results of Redetermination Pursuant to Remand ("Remand Results"), ECF No. 73–1, subsequent to Hyundai Steel I, Commerce conducted a new review of the record and again determined that a particular market situation distorted the cost of hot-rolled steel coil in the Korean market. Remand Results at 4. Commerce again made an upward adjustment to the cost of hot-rolled steel coil, performed the salesbelow-cost test, and calculated normal value from the remaining above-cost home market sales. See id.

In Hyundai Steel II, 44 CIT at \_\_, 483 F. Supp. 3d at 1279, 1281, the Court remanded for Commerce to explain the statutory authority to conduct a cost-based particular market situation analysis when normal value is based on home market sales and to adjust the cost of production for purposes of the sales-below-cost test of 19 U.S.C. § 1677b(b), specifically within the context of relevant caselaw from the U.S. Court of International Trade. Commerce's second remand results explained its view that Section 504 of the Trade Preferences Extension Act of 2015 ("TPEA"), Pub. L. No. 114–27, § 504, 129 Stat. 362, 385, authorizes it to make such determinations and to adjust the cost of production for the sales-below-cost test when calculating normal value based on home market sales. Final Results of Redetermination Pursuant Court Remand ("Second Remand Results") at 3–4, ECF No. 85–1.

In Hyundai Steel III, 45 CIT at \_\_\_, 531 F. Supp. 3d at 1353, the Court concluded that Commerce's cost-based particular market situation determination and subsequent adjustment were not in accordance with the law. The Court held that when normal value is based on home market sales, 19 U.S.C. § 1677b does not permit Commerce to make a particular market situation adjustment to the costs of production for purposes of the sales-below-cost test of 19 U.S.C. § 1677b(b). Id. Under protest, Commerce eliminated the particular market situation adjustment in its recalculation of the weightedaverage dumping margin of Hyundai Steel. See Final Results of Redetermination Pursuant to Court Remand ("Third Remand Results") at 6, ECF No. 94-1; see also 19 C.F.R. § 351.405. Commerce recalculated the dumping margin rate for SeAH by recalculating the rate for the second mandatory respondent, Husteel, using a particular market situation adjustment for Husteel and then relying on a simple average of the recalculated rates for Hyundai Steel and Husteel. Third Remand Results at 6-7.

In *Hyundai Steel IV*, 46 CIT at \_\_, Slip Op. 22–67 at 25–26, the Court sustained Commerce's calculation of Hyundai Steel's dumping margin rate without a particular market situation adjustment, but remanded Commerce's calculation of SeAH's dumping margin based on a particular market situation determination that was unsupported by substantial evidence.

In the remand redetermination under protest, Commerce recalculated the dumping margin for SeAH with no adjustment for a particular market situation in Korea. Fourth Remand Results at 7. Commerce recalculated the average of Husteel's recalculated rate and mandatory respondent Hyundai Steel's rate, which was applied as a new rate to SeAH. Id. at 7–8. SeAH's rate of 19.28 percent from the Final Results was changed to a new rate of 9.77 percent in the Fourth Remand Results. Id. at 8.

#### JURISDICTION AND STANDARD OF REVIEW

The Court has jurisdiction pursuant to Section 516A(a)(2)(B)(i) of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended, 19 U.S.C.  $\S$  1516a(a)(2)(B)(i), and 28 U.S.C.  $\S$  1581(c). The Court will hold unlawful any determination found to be unsupported by substantial evidence on the record or otherwise not in accordance with the law. 19 U.S.C.  $\S$  1516a(b)(1)(B)(i). The Court also reviews determinations made on remand for compliance with the Court's remand order. *Ad Hoc Shrimp Trade Action Comm. v. United States*, 38 CIT \_\_, \_\_, 992 F. Supp. 2d 1285, 1290 (2014), aff'd, 802 F.3d 1339 (Fed. Cir. 2015).

#### **DISCUSSION**

SeAH filed a Motion to Amend Scheduling Order ("Motion to Amend"), ECF No. 117, requesting that the Court issue an expedited amended scheduling order. SeAH explained that because "there were no objections to the draft remand redetermination and there were no changes between the draft and final version of the redetermination on fourth remand, SeAH believes that no further briefing before the Court is necessary." Motion to Amend at 2. Defendant United States and Defendant-Intervenor Wheatland Tube Company consented to the Motion to Amend, and Hyundai Steel did not oppose. *Id.* The Court granted the Motion to Amend. Am. Scheduling Order, ECF No. 118. No parties filed comments with the Court on Commerce's *Fourth Remand Results*.

In the *Fourth Remand Results*, Commerce stated that it recalculated the weighted-average dumping margin of Husteel without an adjustment to account for a particular market situation in Korea, for

the purpose of recalculating SeAH's rate. Fourth Remand Results at 7. Commerce then calculated the average of Husteel's recalculated rate and the other mandatory respondent Hyundai Steel's rate and applied the new rate to SeAH as a non-examined company. Id. at 7–8. Commerce changed the weighted-average dumping margin for SeAH from the prior Final Results rate of 19.28 percent to the recalculated Fourth Remand Results rate of 9.77 percent. Id. at 8.

Commerce's recalculation of SeAH's dumping margin without a particular market situation adjustment is consistent with the Court's prior opinions and orders in *Hyundai Steel II*, *Hyundai Steel III*, and *Hyundai Steel IV*.

#### CONCLUSION

The Court sustains the *Fourth Remand Results*. Judgment will be entered accordingly.
