Project Information – Progress to Date

2014 – 2018 Eastside Strategic Plan

- Library staff spends two years conducting research and outreach to develop the eastside strategic plan. Library staff uses Tell Us: Cuéntenos, an innovative public engagement program, to collect, develop, and record the results of community conversations.
- In 2016, The Library Board and the Common Council adopt Communities Inspiring Libraries: A Strategic Plan for Eastside Growth, which contains the primary recommendation of building the Imagination Center at Reindahl Park.

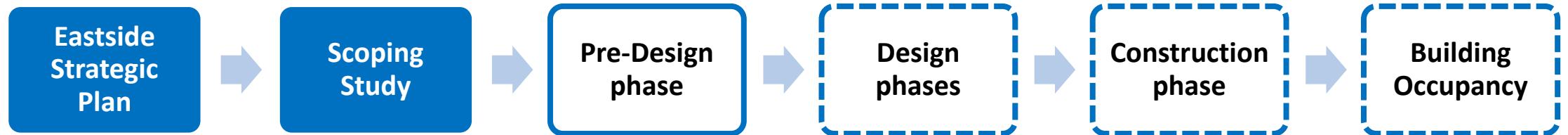
2018 – 2020 Imagination Center Scoping Study

- The Library starts the planning process for the Imagination Center Scoping Study.
- Library staff identifies stakeholders and hosts community conversations throughout Madison around the Imagination Center project. Library staff conducts demographic and service research.
- In 2020 The Library Board and Board of Park Commissioners adopts the Imagination Center Scoping Study (3/11/2020) and directs next steps on design, development, and funding.

2020 Site and Building Predesign phase

- The City advertises a Request for Proposal (RFP) for Design Services from an Architect/Engineer team.
- After a 4 month process, JLA Architects is awarded a contract
- Predesign begins in April, 2021

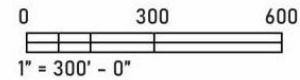

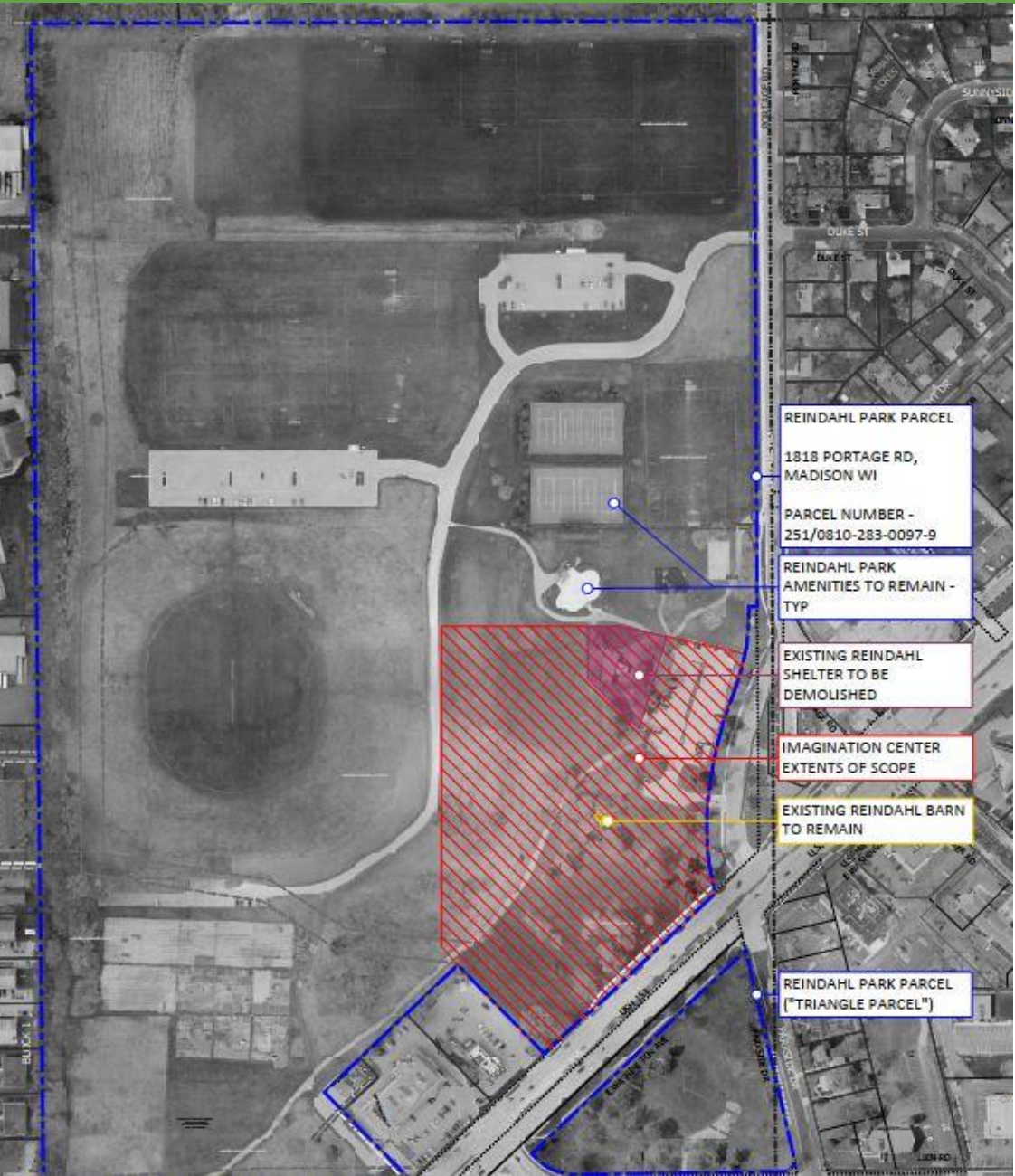

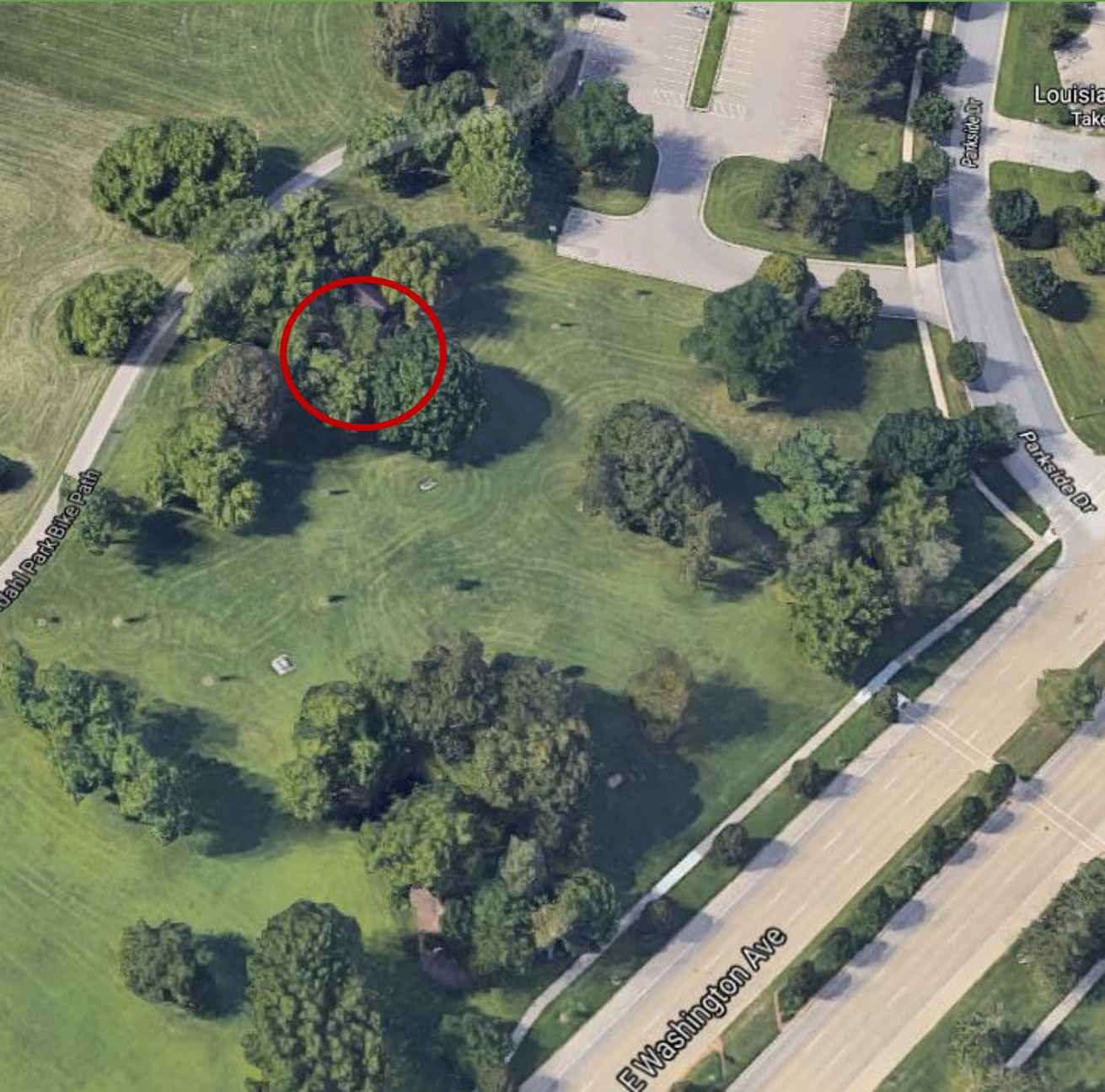

PLACEMAKING

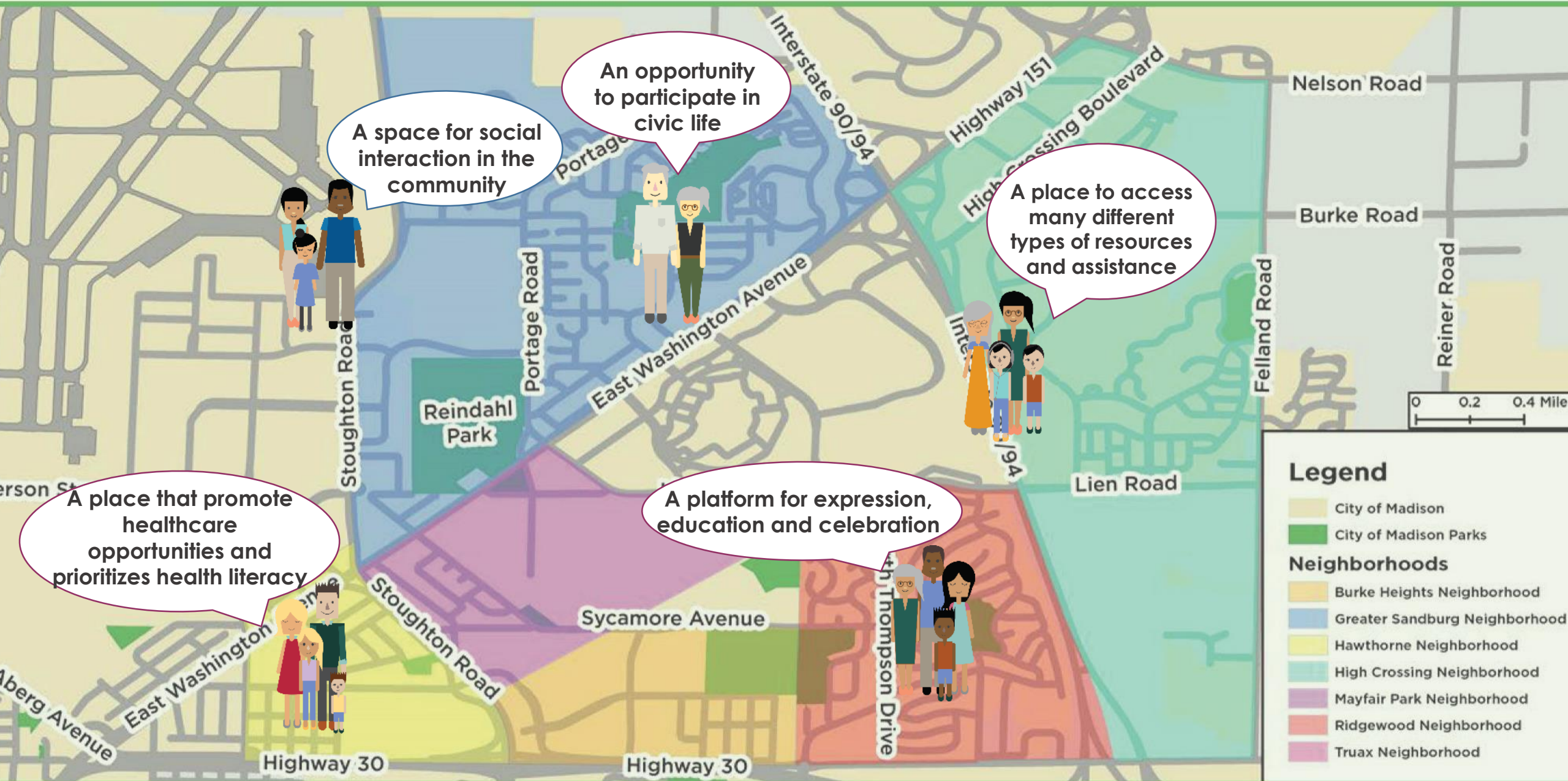
A "place" connotes an emotional attachment to the piece of land.

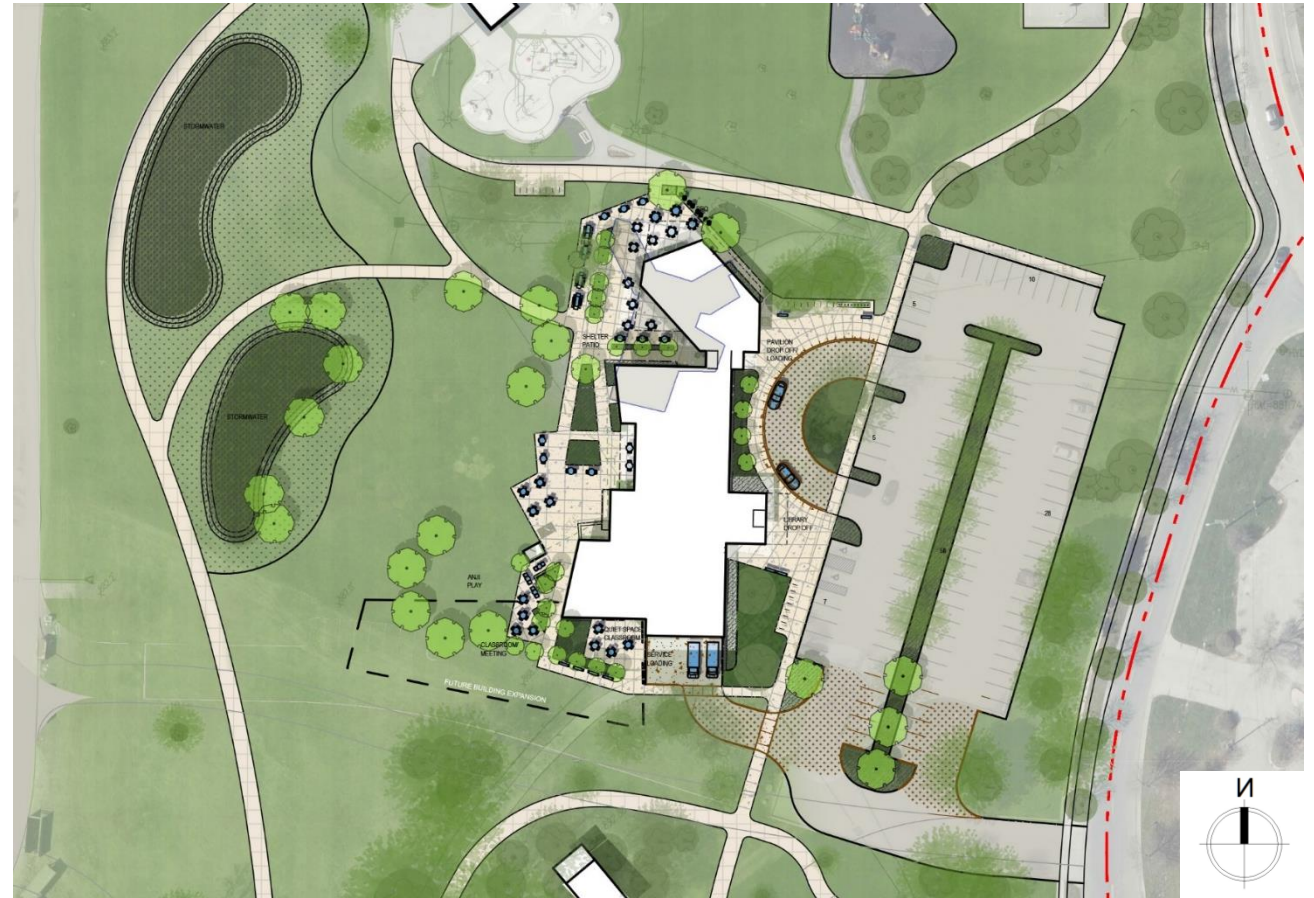
SITE PLAN – EXISTING CONDITIONS
