**STIPULATED AGREEMENT AND ORDER**

The State of Alaska Division of Insurance (Division), **BRADLEY HANSEN**  
**(HANSEN)** the adjuster in this case, stipulate and agree to the following:

I. BACKGROUND

1. On March 16<sup>th</sup>, 2006, the Alaska Department of Commerce, Community and Economic Development, Division of Insurance (Division) issued **HANSEN**, domiciled in the State of Alaska an Insurance Adjuster license number 48058 to transact the business of Property and Casualty

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insurance. The license has an expiration date of Augusts of even numbered years.

2. On July 8<sup>th</sup>, 2022, **HANSEN** sent email correspondence informing the Division of change of resident state from Alaska to Arizona and inquired about renewal of application. That same day, the Division responded with a request to fill out a Resident State/Contact Information Change Form (RSCI) and how to renew **HANSEN's** license. No response was received.
3. On August 25<sup>th</sup>, 2022, **HANSEN** submitted a renewal application, indicating that **HANSEN** was a resident licensee, residing in Anchorage, Alaska.
4. On May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2023, the Division received response to the email referenced in 1.2., including a copy of the RSCI form, with a request for a credit card invoice. The effective date of the move on this form was listed as March 8, 2023. Due to the discrepancy in dates, the Division reached out for clarification, and **HANSEN** responded indicating that he had in fact relocated to Arizona March 8<sup>th</sup>, 2022. The Division imposed a \$200 license penalty for late disclosure fee. **HANSEN** requested a Letter of Clearance (LOC) for the State of Arizona and an additional \$25 fee was imposed by the Division. **HANSEN** paid the license penalty fee for late disclosure of \$200 and \$25 for LOC fees for a total of \$225 on May 19<sup>th</sup>, 2023.

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II. TERMS OF AGREEMENT

A. **HANSEN** provided false information to the Division which subject **HANSEN** to civil penalties. Alaska Statute (AS) 21.27.440(a) provides that “in addition to any other penalties provided by law, a person that the director (director) determines under AS 21.06.170-21.06.240 has violated the provisions of this chapter is subject to (1) a civil penalty equal to the compensation promised, paid, or to be paid, directly or indirectly, to a person in regard to each violation; (2) either a civil penalty of not more than \$10,000 for each violation or a civil penalty of not more than \$25,000 for each violation if the director determines that the person willfully violated the provisions of this chapter; and (3) denial, nonrenewal, suspension, or revocation of a license.” The director has the latitude to impose civil penalties against a person who has violated Alaska’s insurance laws.

B. AS 21.27.025, which states in part that, “(a) A licensee shall notify the director in writing not later than 30 days after a change in residence, place of business...” The Division has authority to revoke under AS 21.27.025(b) which states that “(b) In addition to any other penalty provided by law, a failure to notify the director as required by this section is cause for denial, nonrenewal, suspension, or revocation of a license.”

C. **HANSEN** agrees to pay the penalty fee of \$500 for providing false information on their renewal application.

D. By signing this agreement, **HANSEN** understands and agrees that any failure to comply with the terms of this agreement will be grounds to revoke, suspend, or non-renew Alaska adjuster license number 48058.
