Revocation of Insurance  
Producer License Pursuant  
to AS 21.27.440

**ACCUSATION AND ORDER OF REVOCATION**

1. On December 9, 2021, the Alaska Department of Commerce, Community and Economic Development, Division of Insurance (Division) received an Insurance Producer license application to transact the business of Property and Casualty lines of insurance for **ADAM HAGGART (HAGGART)**, domiciled in the State of Utah.
2. **HAGGART's** application was processed as all background questions were answered "no", the Division issued non-resident license number 3001696220. The license has an expiration date of December 31 on odd numbered years.
3. On November 3, 2023, the Division received renewal application from **HAGGART**. In that renewal application **HAGGART** responded

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negatively to all background questions. The Producer Database reports an administrative action taken against **HAGGART** by the state of North Carolina on October 17, 2023, for failure to disclose a criminal conviction.

4. On November 8, 2023, correspondence was sent to **HAGGART** assessing penalty fees for late disclosure of administrative actions, pursuant to Alaska Statute (AS) 21.27.025.
5. Additional correspondence was sent on November 14, 2023, regarding suspected failure to disclose criminal history.
6. On December 3, 2023, the Division provided **HAGGART** renewal notice informing of the impending expiration date of December 31, 2023.
7. On January 3, 2024, expiration notice was provided to **HAGGART** informing his expired license.
8. On January 8, 2024, the Division sent correspondence informing **HAGGART** of his expired license due to failure to submit all renewal requirements and assessed a civil penalty of \$100 for delayed renewal fee and requested a Business Transaction Form which is due to the Division within 30 days of request. The delayed renewal fee was paid on January 10, 2024.
9. On March 4, 2024, the Division issued a proposed agreement to **HAGGART** assessing \$500 civil penalty under AS 21.27.440 intending to resolve the failure to report his felony conviction at initial application to the State of Alaska.

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10. On March 15, 2024, Addie Thielen, Operations Coordinator for Goosehead Insurance, and authorized submitter for **HAGGART** responded to the Division acknowledging the firm and **HAGGART** received the correspondence provided by the Division.

11. On April 22, 2024 **HAGGART** informed the Division that **HAGGART** and his employer, Goosehead Insurance, elected not to pay the fine and opt for revocation.

12. Failure to comply with Alaska Statute (AS) 21.27.010 subjects **HAGGART** to civil penalties pursuant to AS 21.27.440(a) “in addition to any other penalties provided by law, a person that the director (director) determines under AS 21.06.170-21.06.240 has violated the provisions of this chapter is subject to (1) a civil penalty equal to the compensation promised, paid, or to be paid, directly or indirectly, to a person in regard to each violation; (2) either a civil penalty of not more than \$10,000 for each violation or a civil penalty of not more than \$25,000 for each violation if the director determines that the person willfully violated the provisions of this chapter; and (3) denial, nonrenewal, suspension, or revocation of a license.” The director has the **HAGGART** to impose civil penalties against a person who has violated Alaska’s insurance law.

13. AS 21.27.040(a) states that “(a) Application for a license shall be made to the director upon forms prescribed by the director. As a part of or in connection with the application, the applicant shall furnish information concerning the applicant's identity, personal history, experience, business

1 record, purposes, and other pertinent facts that the director may reasonably  
2 require. The applicant shall declare, subject to penalty of denial,  
3 nonrenewal, suspension, or revocation of a license issued by the director,  
4 that the statements made in or in connection with the application are true,  
5 correct, and complete to the best of the applicant's knowledge and  
6 belief..."

8 14. AS 21.27.020(a) provides: "For the protection of the people of this state,  
9 the director may not issue or renew a license except in compliance with  
10 this chapter and not issue a license to a person, or to be exercised by a  
11 person, found by the director to be untrustworthy, incompetent, or who  
12 has not established to the satisfaction of the director that the person is  
13 qualified under this chapter."

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15 15. AS 21.27.020(b)(4) provides: "To qualify for issuance or renewal of an  
16 individual license, an applicant or licensee shall (4) be a trustworthy  
17 person."

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19 16. AS 21.27.025(b) states that "(b) In addition to any other penalty provided  
20 by law, a failure to notify the director as required by this section is cause  
21 for denial, nonrenewal, suspension, or revocation of a license."  
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25 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED**, under the provisions of AS 21.27.440, that **ADAM**  
26 **HAGGART's** Insurance Producer license number 3002590198 is REVOKED for  
27 a period of one year. If **HAGGART** applies to reinstate his license he is subject to  
28 all civil penalties assessed in this order.
