ACCUSATION AND FINAL ORDER

Lori Wing-Heier, Director of the Division of Insurance (Division), Department of
Commerce, Community, and Economic Development (DCCED), State of Alaska, states
the issues on which the accusation is based as follows:

1. On December 15, 2023, **TROY JOSEPH HAMILTON (HAMILTON)**,
domiciled in the State of Texas applied for an Independent Adjuster
license requesting Casualty, and Property authority with the Division to
conduct insurance business in the State of Alaska.
2. Upon review of the application, **HAMILTON** responded negatively to
background question 1A, indicating no criminal convictions to report to
the State of Alaska.

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3. The Attachment Warehouse indicated **HAMILTON** was convicted of a misdemeanor in the State of Indiana in effect September 8, 2014. The documentation in the warehouse received from **HAMILTON** stated **HAMILTON** has a misdemeanor conviction. **HAMILTON** failed to provide complete information on his initial application and responded to the background questions incorrectly.
4. On December 27, 2023, correspondence was provided to **HAMILTON** informing of the conflicting information reported in the Producer Database and his failure to respond accurately to the background question regarding misdemeanor conviction. The Division provided **HAMILTON** the opportunity to voluntarily withdraw the application and provide a new, complete, and accurate application within 30 days. No response was received.
5. AS 21.27.040(a) states that “(a) Application for a license shall be made to the director upon forms prescribed by the director. As a part of or in connection with the application, the applicant shall furnish information concerning the applicant's identity, personal history, experience, business record, purposes, and other pertinent facts that the director may reasonably require. The applicant shall declare, subject to penalty of denial, nonrenewal, suspension, or revocation of a license issued by the director, that the statements made in or in connection with the application are true, correct, and complete to the best of the applicant's knowledge and belief...”

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- 1 6. AS 21.27.020(a) provides: "For the protection of the people of this state,
2 the director may not issue or renew a license except in compliance with
3 this chapter and not issue a license to a person, or to be exercised by a
4 person, found by the director to be untrustworthy, incompetent, or who
5 has not established to the satisfaction of the director that the person is
6 qualified under this chapter."

8 7. AS 21.27.020(b)(4) provides: "To qualify for issuance or renewal of an
9 individual license, an applicant or licensee shall (4) be a trustworthy
10 person."

12 8. Pursuant to AS 21.27.040(a), **HAMILTON** failed to report his complete
13 criminal conviction to the Division at initial application. Based on the
14 above **HAMILTON's** Independent Adjuster license application is hereby
15 DENIED.

19 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED**, under the provisions of AS 21.27.040(a) that **TROY JOSEPH**
20 **HAMILTON** application for the Independent Adjuster license application in Alaska under
21 National Producer Number (NPN) # 19848087 is DENIED for supplying inaccurate information
22 on the initial application for licensure.
