Statutory & Regulation Authority:

AS 04.11.480(a): “A local governing body may protest the issuance, renewal, relocation, or transfer to another person of a license by sending the board and the applicant a protest and the reasons for the protest within 60 days of receipt from the board of notice of filing of the application... The board shall consider a protest and testimony received at a hearing conducted under AS 04.11.510(b)(2) or (4) when it considers the application... If an application or continued operation is protested, the board shall deny the application or continued operation unless the board finds that the protest is arbitrary, capricious, and unreasonable.”

AS 04.11.510(b)(2): “The board may review an application for the issuance, renewal, transfer of location, or transfer to another person of a license without affording the applicant notice or hearing, except... (2) the board may, on its own initiative or in response to an objection or protest, hold a hearing to ascertain the reaction of the public or a local governing body to an application if a hearing is not required under this subsection;”

3 AAC 304.145(h) “The board may uphold a protest of an application or continued operation with a single abeyance period not to exceed 180 days if the local governing body indicates that the protest is subject to rescission and that it will be withdrawn if the applicant meets conditions set by the local governing body. If the local governing body notifies the board within the period of the abeyance that the protest has been removed, the application or continued operation is approved when all other applicable requirements have been met. If the local governing body has not notified the board within the period of the abeyance that it has removed the protest, the application or continued operation is denied. The period of abeyance may not be extended or renewed.”

Background: At the June 28, 2022 ABC Board meeting, the board approved the Beverage Dispensary application with delegation. On August 1, 2022, the Matanuska-Susitna Borough protested the transfer application pending issuance of the Conditional Use Permit.

Staff Recommendation: Consider the Matanuska-Susitna Borough’s protest and determine if the protest is arbitrary, capricious, and unreasonable. If it is not, rescind the previous approval and uphold the protest with a 180 - day abeyance period.

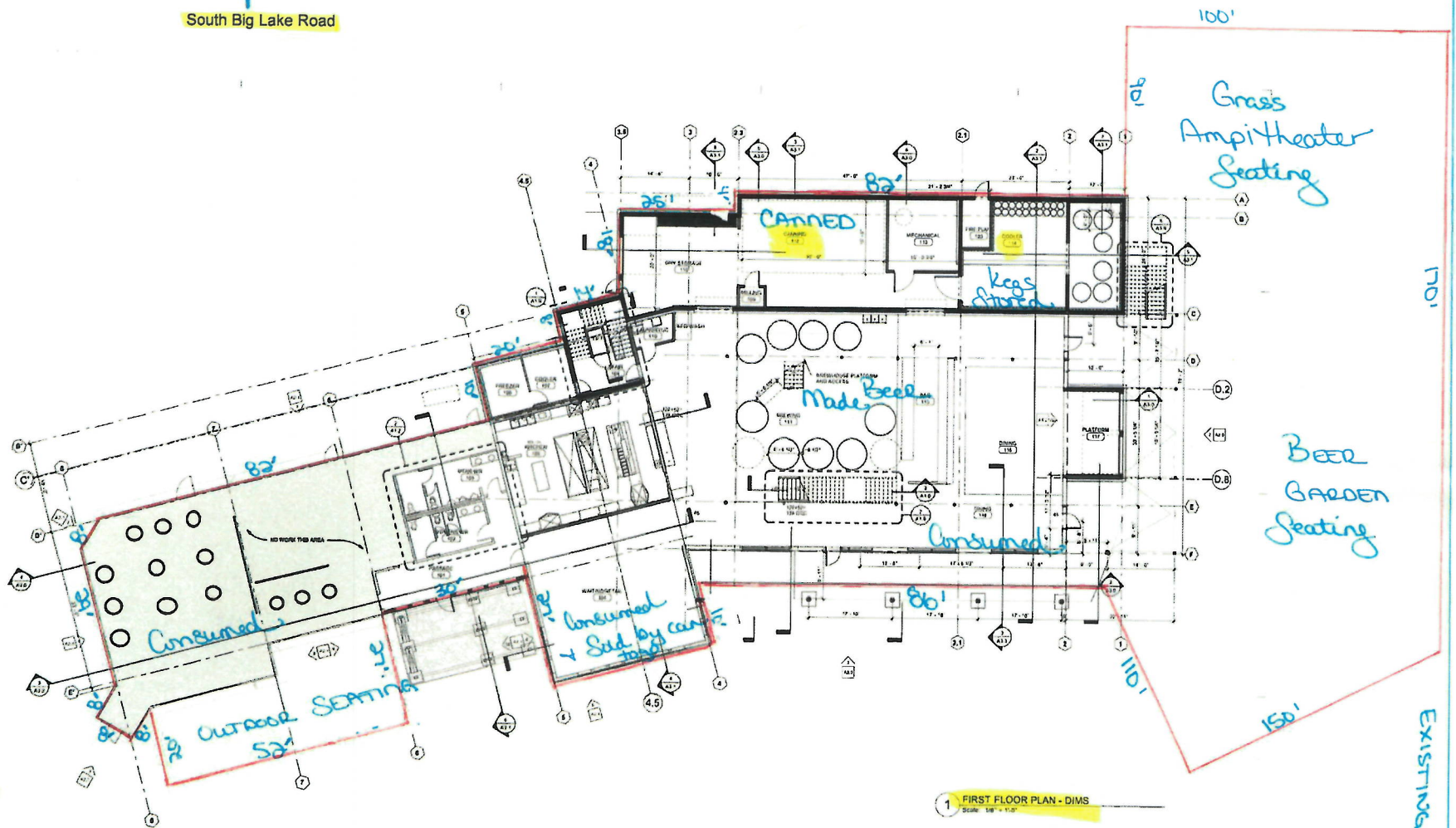

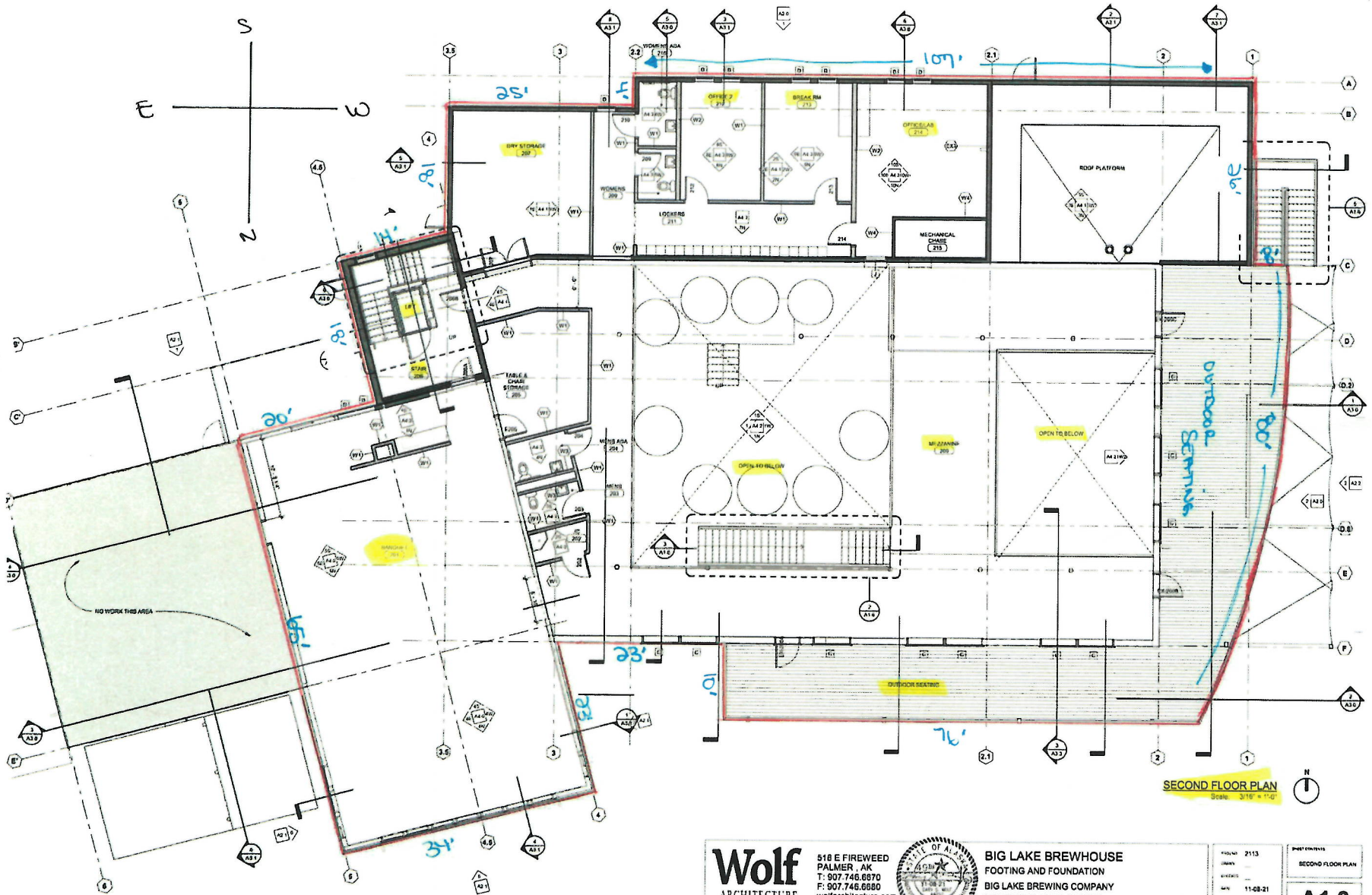

Indoor/Outdoor Security Plan

1. All minors must be accompanied by an adult over the age of 21 while in restricted areas, when alcohol is being served, sold or consumed. Underaged guests will be monitored by our trained alcohol serving professionals.
2. All new guests are carded upon ordering alcohol.
3. All staff serving alcohol has completed the TAPS class, and has been trained in the identification of fake, and valid state issued identification.
4. Proper egress from the outdoor service area will always remain unobstructed.
5. Fencing as follows:
 - a. Outdoor fencing on the east end of the building (in front of the single-story café) will be 42" high and made of cable railing.
 - b. Outdoor beer garden/amphitheater on the west side of the building will be 42" high chain link.
6. All ABC mandated posters are displayed and posted inside Big Lake Brewing Company, and at the entrances of the outdoor seating.
7. All entrances and exits will provide clear notice that **NO ALCOHOL IS ALLOWED BEYOND THE OUTDOOR SEATING AREA.**
8. Keeping outdoor seating area viable without any increased risk to minors exposed to alcohol is always part of training for our new staff and is ongoing with existing members.
9. All safety related operations for our current liquor service will additionally be enforced in the new service area.
10. Proper signage at points of entry indicating no minors without a parent or legal guardian will be posted.
11. All servers will closely monitor that only the guests that have their ID checked, will have alcoholic beverages.
12. Our top priority continues in providing safety for all guests regarding the service of alcoholic beverages, even those not consuming alcohol.
13. Servers will be present in the outdoor area to monitor consumption.
 - a. We will have 24-hour per day, operational security cameras covering the outdoor seating. Indoor cameras are also present to monitor activity.

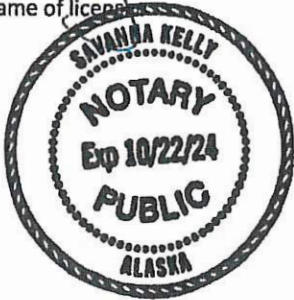
