Our hotel has 90+ rooms available to the general public and during the summer, tour groups from all over the world. We currently have 3 rooms with a small kitchenette. We do not supply the mini-fridge with alcoholic beverages. Due to covid, we have not opened our restaurant the last 2 years and have only taken on group meals on a case by case basis. Many of our guests are part of tour groups that have prearranged excursions in Valdez. Whether glacier cruises or fishing expeditions, the summer tourists that visit us in Valdez have limited dining options compared to larger cities and towns.

This facility was built and housed the people that constructed the Alaska oil pipeline. From then to now, the hotel has had numerous travelers from all over the world to see Alaska. 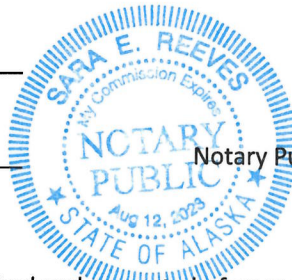
