To The Honorable Members of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board:

Glacier View Ventures LLC DBA Long Rifle Lodge sits on the magnificent panorama of the Matanuska Glacier in Sutton and has ten (10) hotel rooms. There will be no stocking of alcoholic beverages in any rooms. All rooms currently in service will remain, and they will continue to capture the natural simplicity of Glacier View. Rooms are updated, and amenities are added as needed. Long Rifle Lodge is not located within an airport terminal. We feel that this approach and design of the hotel will encourage and promote tourism to the area as this lodge will provide a venue for families to stay, eat, and enjoy the dynamic environment of the Matanuska Valley, Sutton, and Glacier View areas. We have over 20 Alaskan animal mounts on display, and our view of the glacier is unmatched. We serve local products, homemade pastries, and Alaskan Microbrews to locals and folks visiting our area. We cater to tourists that have spent their day glacier trekking, ice climbing, white water rafting, and flightseeing. Everyone enjoys a drink after a long day outside.

Long Rifle Lodge is a full-service dining restaurant that caters to families and casual dining experiences, serving hamburgers and fries, sandwiches, tacos, burritos, and even homemade pies and pastries for dessert. The goal of the menu is to provide meals that can be budget friendly for families but also have some variety for customers with different tastes. Long Rifle Lodge's restaurant has 10 indoor tables and 4 outdoor tables for guests to enjoy a meal while basking in the beauty of Glacier View. An estimated 450,000 out-of-state visitors traveled in 2022 to the Mat-Su Borough (according to the July 2022 Mat-Su Sustainable Tourism Master Plan.) The most common Mat-Su destinations among summer visitors were Talkeetna at 310,000 visitors and Palmer/Wasilla at 225,000; an additional 27,000 visited other Mat-Su destinations such as Willow, Byers Lake, Hatcher Pass, and Sheep Mountain. Long Rifle Lodge is less than one mile from the Matanuska Glacier Scenic turnout in the Mat-Su Borough and will continue to promote tourism in this area and surrounding areas.

The tourism industry is a significant economic driver for the Matanuska-Susitna Borough. Long Rifle Lodge, though available year-round, is a staple in the tourism industry, which, as previously mentioned, is extremely important to the economic impact of the Mat-Su Borough, the Sutton/Glacier View area, and in turn, the State of Alaska. The central focus of the Long Rifle Lodge is catering to out-of-town tourists, local and regional guests. We intend to also include persons or families traveling to or from Anchorage and other Alaskan communities in our tourism expansions. We feel they deserve just as much recognition for the expansion of tourism as the money is being spent the same to benefit other tourism hot spots in Alaska.

By the ABC permitting the transfer of this liquor license, Long Rifle Lodge will be able to continue to encourage tourism and increase the revenue for Sutton and the Matanuska – Susitna Valley, and around the Matanuska Glacier. The ability to serve a glass of wine, beer, or a mixed drink while dining at the Long Rifle Lodge or before staying at the lodge can mean the difference between guests staying an extra night or two rather than traveling back to a Wasilla hotel where they can receive these amenities, decreasing the motive to plan a return visit. We have renovated the existing outdoor seating area to keep the amenities modern and will continue to update the lodge as needed. We want to offer all our guests the amenities offered at one stop, as does Anchorage, so our guests will have everything available to make their stay as comfortable, memorable, and returnable as possible. We advertise the Matanuska Glacier, Campgrounds, and Rental cabins and work with local companies to advertise their flightseeing, hiking, white water rafting, and fishing businesses.

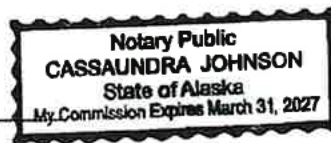

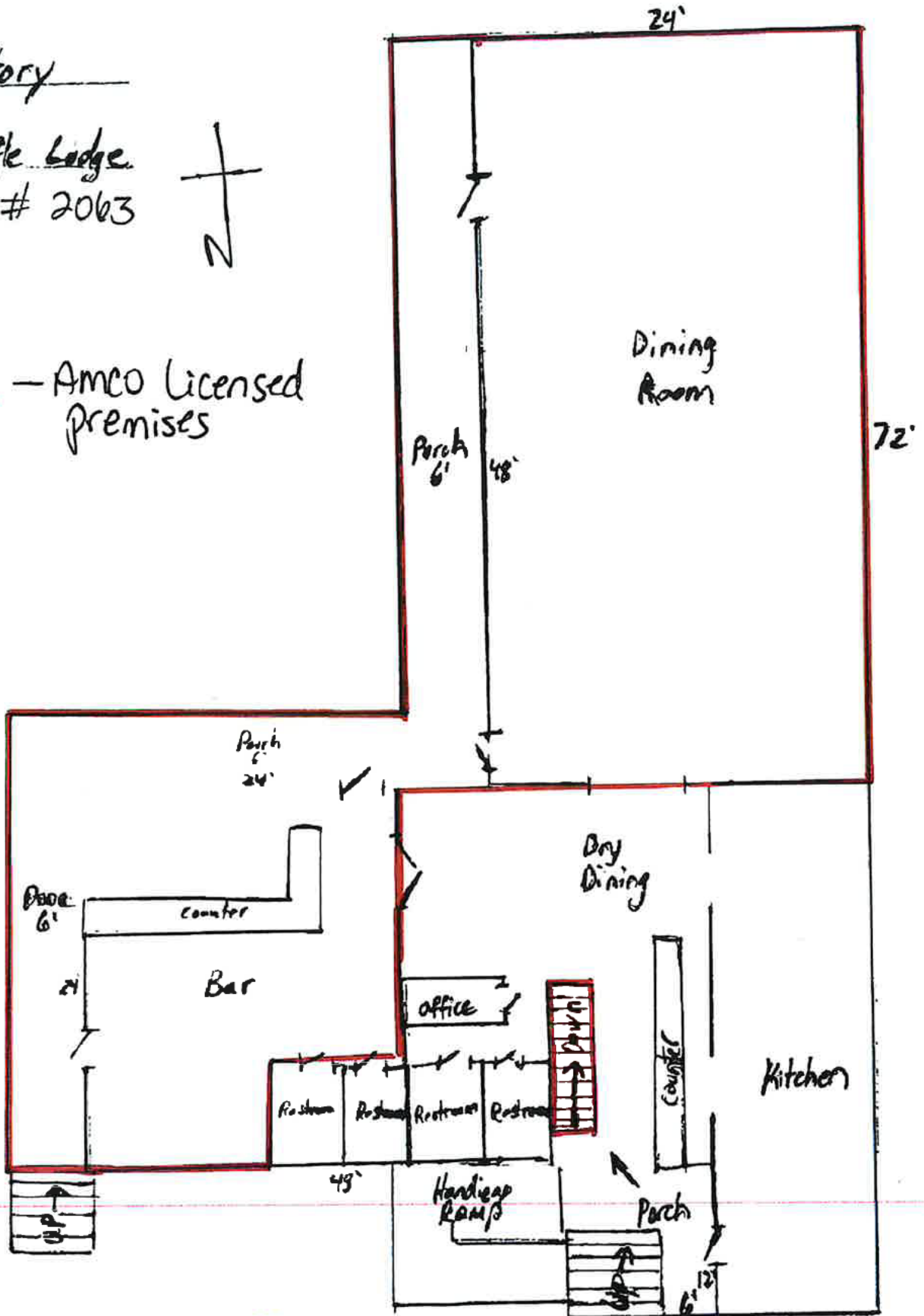

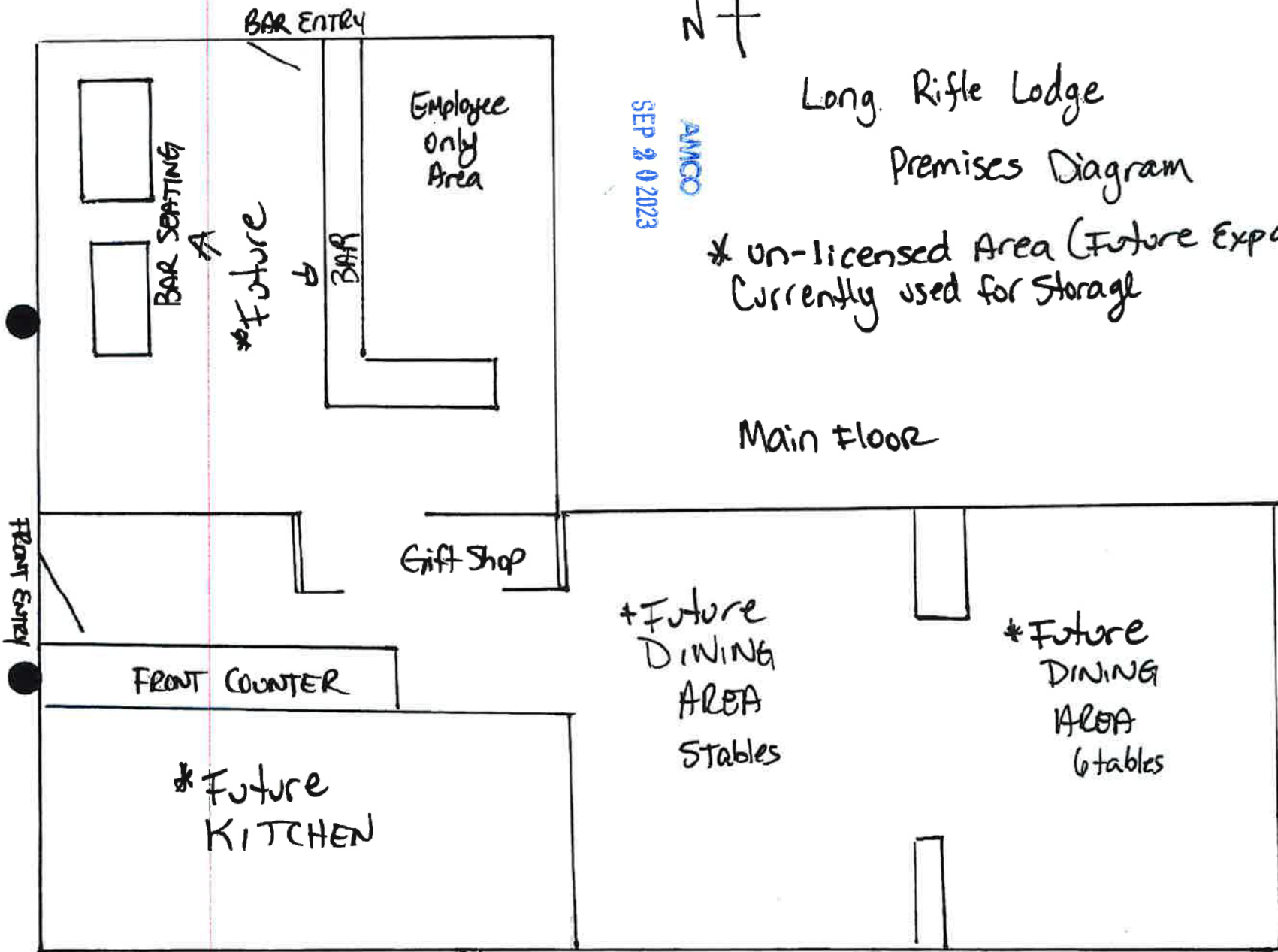
Long Rifle Lodge Premises Diagram

Long Rifle Lodge will ensure that no minors will gain access to alcohol while on the premises by checking the ID of every person who orders an alcoholic beverage, regardless of appearance. Employees and management will keep a close eye on all patrons actions, ensuring that no person who has not had their ID checked is handed an alcoholic beverage and authorized staff members (TAPS Certified) will quickly clean up unfinished drinks when patrons leave. If an employee witnesses a patron handing a minor alcohol, they will immediately contact management, who will contact local law enforcement and the patron will be dealt with accordingly.

Minor employees will be supervised by TAPS certified staff at all times, and will not sell, serve, deliver or dispense alcoholic beverages per AS 04.16.049. Minors will be employed in the kitchen area, dish-washing and serving food only and assisting in bussing tables without removing consumed alcoholic beverages from tables. All servers are TAPS certified and will verify valid government issued photo identification for every customer.
