2.1. Explain how issuance of a liquor license at your establishment has/will encourage tourism.

Denali Totem Inn is open year-round and with the only year-round pub in Healy we have the opportunity to attract tourism as in international and seasonal locals coming to the Denali area in the summer and traveling Alaskans year-round. Our policy is "Safely Entertain our Customers." So we have 5 tv's broadcasting (sports mostly). A Wii game is hooked up to one TV and a Xbox console is hooked up to another TV. We have two well maintained pool tables, and a foosball table that accepts Totem Tokens. For Free Play we have a SnapBack Shuffleboard tables, and 4 classic arcade tables.

2.2. Explain how the facility was/will be constructed or improved as required by AS 04.11.400(d)(1):

Early in the year we are updating our flooring in the Pub along with the Restaurant. As part of our "Safely Entertain the Customers Policy" the plans are in the works for building (in-house) additional classic arcade gaming tables with larger monitors. We have board games rotating in and out as our bartenders introduce them. A 3D Printed Chess Set is also being made so customers don't have to bring their own sets.

Our Restaurant is open from Noon to 9 p.m. We have two areas for restaurant-seated dining: one with alcohol allowed and the other dining room, which is larger, in which no alcohol is allowed. The Pub opens at 4 p.m. and offers the same menu until the kitchen closes at 9 p.m. The menu includes Burgers, Pastas and Pizzas and some hot sandwiches. We have been expanding our Greek menu items successfully. To-go orders comprise about a quarter of our business.

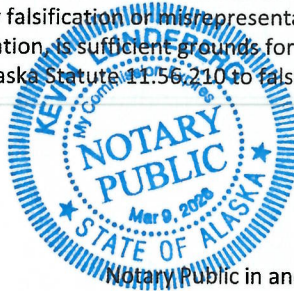
