Requested Action: Refund request and renewal for the 2023-2024 renewal period.

Statutory and Regulatory Authority: **AS 04.06.090(b):** “The board shall review all applications for licenses made under this title and may order the director to issue, renew, revoke, transfer, or suspend licenses and permits authorized under this title.”

AS 04.11.570: “(a) If an application for a license is denied, the board shall refund the license fee less the application fee. (b) A license fee may not be refunded after the license has been issued unless the board determines it has erred in the issuance through no fault of the applicant. (c) If a license is revoked on grounds that statements made in the application are untrue, the license fee paid by the applicant is forfeited to the state.”

3 AAC 304.105(d) “A non-refundable application fee of \$300 must accompany an application for license renewal.”

AAC 304.170. Waiver of annual operating requirement and minimum operating requirements. “(c) An application for waiver for a calendar year must be made in writing to the board and must be accompanied by a non-refundable application fee of:

- (1) an amount equal to one-half the applicable biennial license fee if a waiver application was not made for the previous year;”

“(h) In addition to the application fee under (c) of this section, the applicant shall pay \$1,000 for an application that is received too late for board consideration at its last meeting of the calendar year for which waiver is requested.”

Staff Rec.: Evaluate refund request in accordance with above statutes and regulation and approve the renewal application.

Background: The licensee is requesting a refund of \$1,500.00 associated with the 2022 AB-29 waiver application. The licensee paid the following on April 14, 2023:

Dear AMCO Board of Directors,

I'm Alex MacGillivray and I own and operate Baleen Brewing Co LLC (#5883) in Ketchikan, Alaska. I started brewing in 2018 and things were going great and I enjoyed launching my career change from nursing to brewing.

In 2020 I began the process of moving the brewery from the Ketchikan Gateway Borough into Ketchikan city center. Then the COVID mandates appeared and changed everything for me and I'm still feeling the reverberations of that to this date.

The first slow down was communications with AMCO since everyone was expected to stay home and work remotely. That hindered me but didn't stop me. I paid for my license then, believing I'd be up and running in a matter of weeks to months.

The next delay was getting a consultation with the local plumbers, electricians, and HVAC contractors. The limitations were a major lack of capable workers, again related to COVID. The HVAC company finally came to inspect and consult for the exhaust system. It took 12 months from first contacting them, to building the exhaust tubing, to final installation. They cited that the delay was qualified staff to perform the work as well as the outsourced company in Washington where the construction of the exhaust system itself was done.

The plumbers had similar complaints stating the obtaining the tubing for the glycol system and fittings was also a delay as they ordered the supplies from down south. The work was fairly timely taking only 2 months from first contact to completions.

The electrician has been fairly steady but still has not completed the work which he had started in 2020. He was delayed by lack of workers and also by the intervention of the fire marshal.

The fire marshal demanded that I perform a major overhaul of the building to bring it up to code. This was a surprise since when I started this process in 2020, the fire marshal at that time said I was in compliance and my plan needed no intervention on inspection. As of today I'm required to a large list to meet the demands of the new fire marshal. To be sure, I've never once delayed this process myself and always came up with the money I needed to get the contractors paid and paid in full.

My career is in nursing. I work for the State of Alaska and have been since 1998 at the Ketchikan Pioneers' Home. Since last October I've been working seven days a week ten hours a day. I've only recently cut my hours to fifty hours a week. Nearly all the money I've made there as gone into this project. As it is now, I've paid roughly \$130,000 just to install the brewery and bring the brewery up to code. I've paid all my State and Federal excise tax on time and I've been made aware the bond I submitted to the State will be reimbursed to me because of that.

I am asking the Board to refund the \$1,500 I paid for the AB-29 form. This is a large amount of money to me, of which I'm paying with my nursing practice and not my brewing practice. The only fault of mine was to move the brewery into town naïve to the fact of the amount of time it would take to be up and running. To me it's stunning and unfortunate, but I'm also determined to make this a reality.

Please consider returning the money to me to I can use it to open my brewery back up as soon as possible.
