Keg Registration (*AS 04.21.012*)

- Discuss proposed keg registration form and regulatory language for the required tagging
- Keg registration form is required to be filled out by purchaser and licensee (*agent or employee*)
 - Kept on file and available for inspection by licensee for 1 year

Form AB-XX: Keg Registration Form

Please read the following information carefully before signing and dating this form

Per AS 04.21.012(a) A person may not purchase a keg or similar container holding four or more gallons of an alcoholic beverage unless the person provides proof that the person is over 21 years of age and completes and signs a registration form.

AS 04.21.012(b) A licensee or an agent or employee of a licensee who sells or offers for sale a keg or similar container holding four or more gallons of an alcoholic beverage shall require a purchaser to show acceptable proof of age under AS 04.21.050(b) and sign the sworn statement on a registration form.

AS 04.21.012(d) A licensee or an agent or employee of a licensee who sells a keg or similar container holding four or more gallons of an alcoholic beverage without completing a registration form or affixing a temporary ID tag to the keg or container commits the crime of selling alcoholic beverages in an unregistered keg.

Purchaser: I hereby certify that I am the person acquiring the keg or similar container identified in this registration form, that I am over 21 years of age, that I am not acquiring this keg or container for individuals under the age of 21, and that I will not remove or obliterate the identifying tag on the keg or container.

Keg Registration (*AS 04.21.012*)

Proposed verbiage added to regulation 3 AAC 305.680

(f) The temporary tag required under *AS 04.21.012* shall be provided by the licensee. The tag must

- (1) consist of plastic metal, paper, or durable material that is not easily damaged or destroyed;
- (2) be attached to a keg at the time of sale with a nylon tie or cording, wire tie, other metal attachment device, or other durable means of tying or attaching the tag to the keg;
- (3) contain:
 - (A) the licensee's name, address, and telephone number;
 - (B) a prominently visible warning that intentional removal or defacement of the tag is a violation of *AS 04.21.012*; and
 - (C) the unique identifying number from the accompanying keg registration form.



Keg Registration (AS 04.21.012)

- Tag with licensee information and unique identifying number affixed to keg at time of purchase





Common Carrier Approval (*AS 04.09.750*)

- The board *may* choose to require periodic reporting of approved common carriers on a form prescribed by the board (subsection(d))

Why is this form needed?

SHORT FORM

Registration Fee: \$1,250

Per AS 04.09.750, a common carrier may not transport or deliver alcoholic beverages to a person in the state unless the ABC board has approved the common carrier.

Per AS 04.09.750(c) delivering alcoholic beverages to a person in the state shall ensure that the package containing alcoholic beverages is delivered directly to a person who:

- (1) Presents identification and acceptable proof of age under AS 04.21.050 showing that the person is 21 years of age or older; and
- (2) Provides a signature acknowledging that the person received the package.

Per AS 04.09.750(d) an approved common carrier shall make records of shipments of alcoholic beverages to persons in the state available for inspection and audit by the board.

Form AB-XX: Common Carrier Approval Registration

Why is this form needed?

LONG FORM

Registration Fee: \$1,250

Per AS 04.09.750, a common carrier may not transport or deliver alcoholic beverages to a person in the state unless the ABC board has approved the common carrier.

In section two (2) of this form, a detailed diagram (or description) of the secure storage location where alcohol will be held (both prior to and after transport) is required. Your diagram (or description) must include dimensions and must show all entrances and boundaries of the premises, walls, bars, fixtures, and areas of storage.

In section three (3) of this form, you must describe how the carrier will verify age and obtain a signature of the recipient. You must also state where records of shipments of alcoholic beverages will be held and made available for inspection and audit by the ABC board.

Per AS 04.09.750(c) delivering alcoholic beverages to a person in the state shall ensure that the package containing alcoholic beverages is delivered directly to a person who:

- (1) Presents identification and acceptable proof of age under AS 04.21.050 showing that the person is 21 years of age or older; and
- (2) Provides a signature acknowledging that the person received the package.
