Background: This is an application to transfer a Beverage Dispensary – Tourism license to Baranof Lounge LLC in the City and Borough of Sitka.

AS 04.11.400(d)(2)(A)(ii) requires that the facility must maintain at least the minimum number of rental rooms required at original licensure. Staff has determined that the license is compliant with the room number requirements.

This facility has guest rooms with no kitchen facilities. There is a dining area with table and counter services with a will offer a limited menu with table and counter service, in addition to a secure outdoor alcohol service area in the form of a tent with seating for guests on the premises.

The 907 Lodge is a short ride from the Sitka airport and is at the heart of the city of Sitka. Providing the Baranof Lodge LLC DBA 907 Lounge with a liquor license will encourage tourism by being a strong draw to tourist to stay at the hotel as there is the added benefit of having a bar within walking distance outside their hotel room.

The Baranof Lodge was re-branded from its former name of the Sitka Super 8 Motel, and since then many improvements has been made on and outside the building. Security Plan

To ensure that restricted persons, including minors will not be served or consume alcohol on the premises, and protect the safety of all guests, Baranof Lodge dob 907 Lounge will do the following:

- Check IDs for every member purchasing alcohol
- Minors will not be allowed in the service area
- Minors will not be allowed access to alcohol
- All servers will closely monitor that only the guests that have been carded will be allowed in the service area and when served alcohol
- Any alcohol purchased within the tent area must remain in the tent area
- Any alcohol purchased in the bar area must remain in the bar ara
- All entrances and exits will provide clear notice that NO ALCOHOL IS ALLOWED OUTSIDE PREMISES, for both the inner bar and tent area.
- Entrance to the tent area will have an employee checking id's for all patrons who wish to enter the area to ensure they are 21 or older, and will be ensuring that no alcohol is allowed to leave the tent area.
- No outside alcohol will be allowed into the service area
- All staff is trained to identify fake IDs
- All staff will be of the age of 21 or older
- There will always be a manager of or above the age of 21 present
- Any employees handling/serving alcohol must have current server training certification, aka Training for Professionals (TAP) as required by the State of Alaska
- ABC mandated posters as required by law are posted inside the business
- Alcohol sales will continue to be a part of 907 Lounge training
- All safety related operations for any liquor service will be enforced
- Providing safety for all guests regarding the service of alcoholic beverages will be strictly enforced
