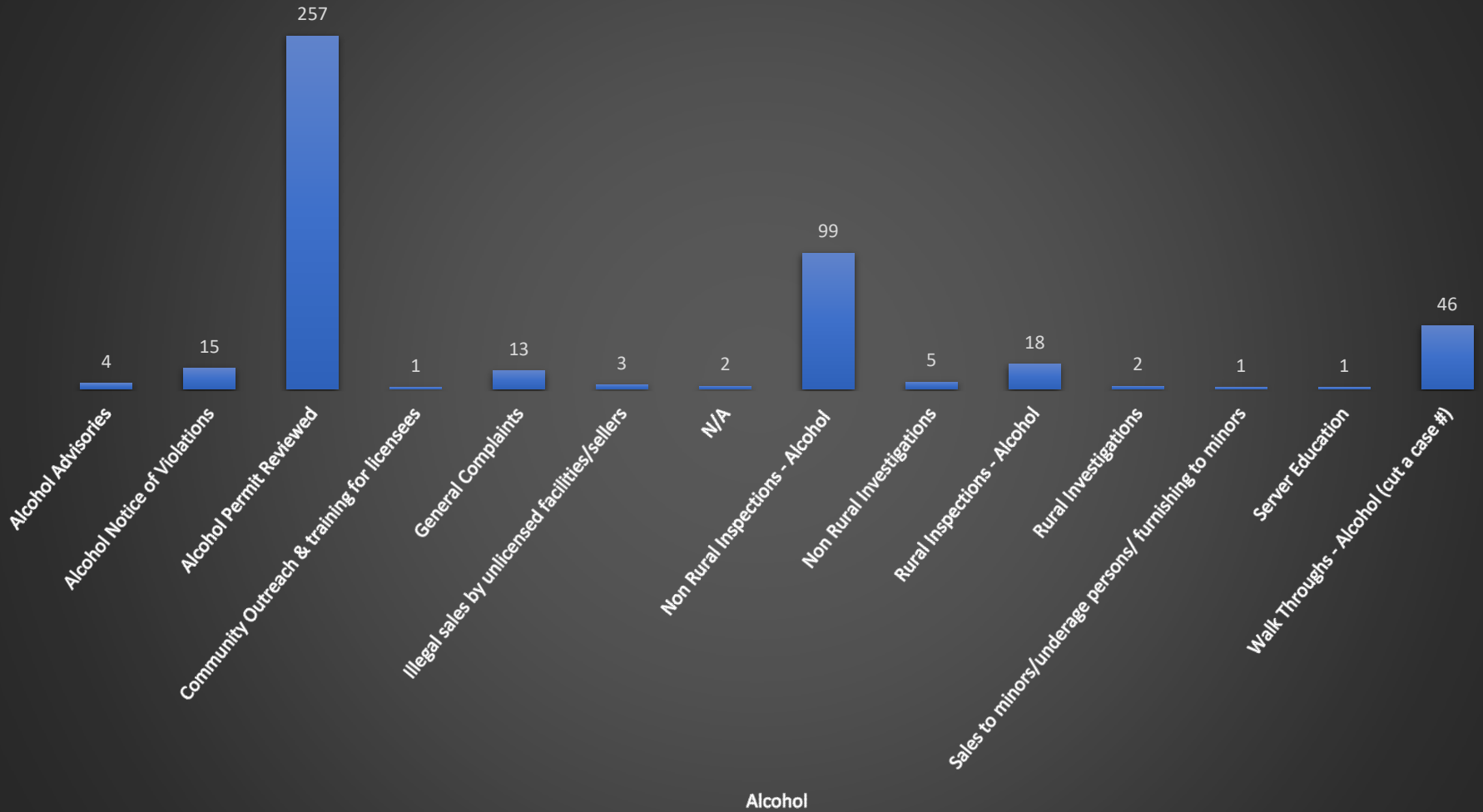
AMCO Enforcement has been working diligently to ensure a smooth transition with the implementation of the Title 4 rewrite. We continue to field a high volume of questions from licensees, local governments and members of the public. Quick reference cards were created for patrol officers and will be available to law enforcement agencies across the State.

Enforcement has also been assisting Licensing with the monumental task of launching the new licensing system, AK-ACCIS. We have contacted a significant number of licensees who needed to claim their business, apply for specific endorsements or renew their license. We understand the large amount of work this has added to their normal operations and remain ready to assist as needed.

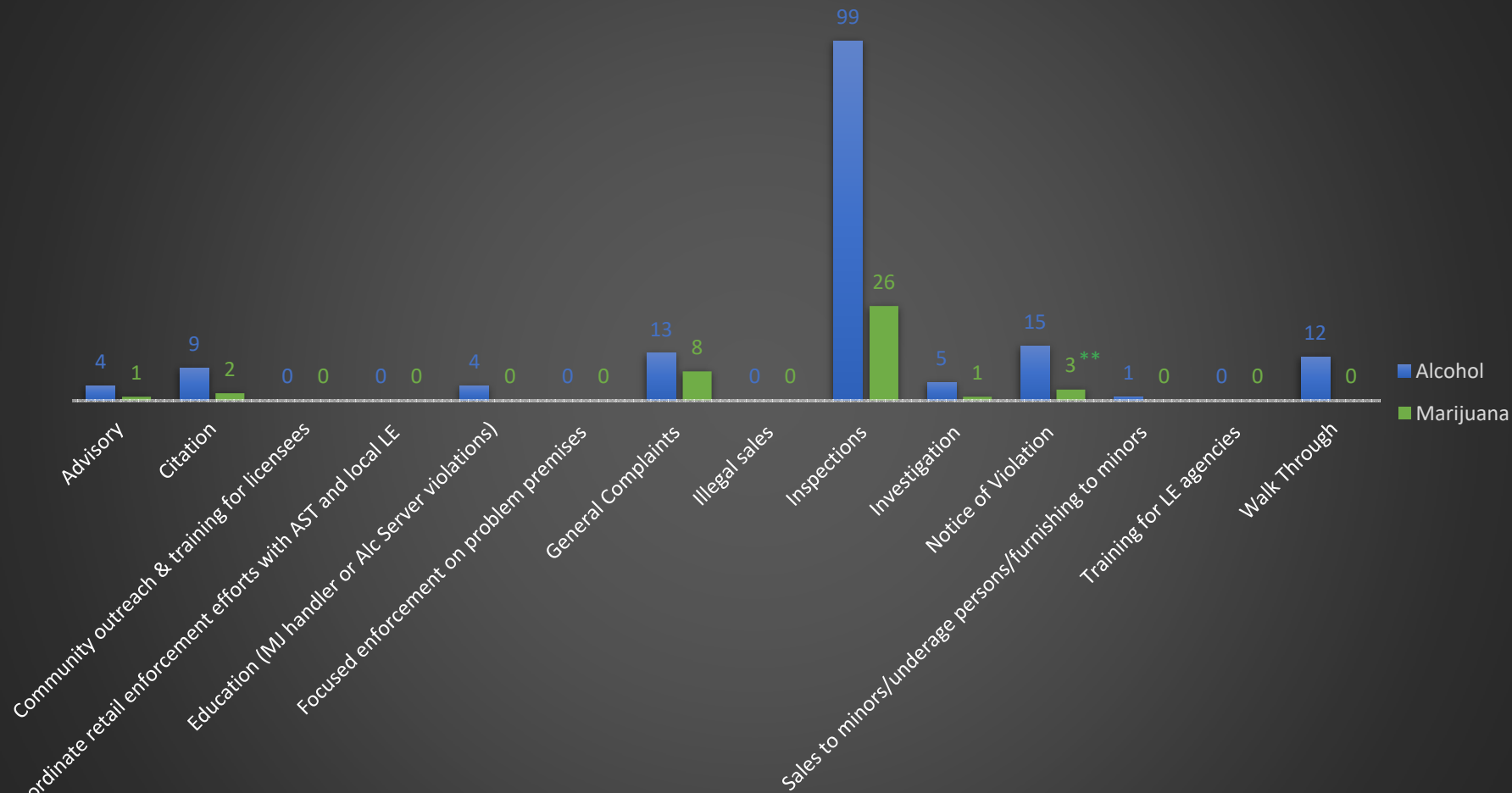
The first citations for Title 4 violations have been issued. The process is working as intended and has streamlined our ability to take meaningful enforcement action.
