

- You received a CBP One App appointment and presented at a U.S. Port of Entry
- You applied for asylum by filing Form I-589, Application for Asylum and for Withholding of Removal, and your asylum application has been pending for at least 150 days.




After creating an account, file Form I-765, Application for Employment Authorization.

NOTE: if unable to pay the filing fee, a paper form must be submitted with a fee waiver form.

Items you will need to provide as evidence for Form I-765 include:

- Either: a copy of your stamped form I-94, Arrival/Departure Record, a printout of your electronic form I-94, a copy of your passport, or other travel document
- If you were not issued an EAD, a copy of a government-issued identity document and Form G-28 (if you are represented by an attorney or accredited representative)



You cannot file Form I-765 electronically if requesting a fee waiver.

If approved, USCIS will mail your work permit to the address you provided in your application. If you submit any documents in a foreign language, you must include a full English translation along with a translator certification.
