DETERMINATION OF NON-SIGNIFICANCE

Description of proposal: The proposal consists of 69.4 acres of even-aged timber harvest, salvage, and fiber recovery (totaling approximately 2063 MBF and 290 tons), 212 feet of road construction, and 240 cubic yards of spoils. This review only covers the Forest Practices Application (FPA) activities as described in FPA #2942749. Proposals for future activities related to this site may require additional SEPA review.
