## DETERMINATION OF NON-SIGNIFICANCE

**Description of proposal:** The proposal consists of 26.2 acres of even-aged timber harvest, and salvage (totaling approximately 1350 MBF and 150 tons), 5475 feet of road construction, 4765 feet of road abandonment, and 2 stream crossings. This review only covers the Forest Practices Application (FPA) activities as described in FPA #2942800. Proposals for future activities related to this site may require additional SEPA review.
